1. GENERAL SITUATION

a. The 817th Air Base Group is a combat-ready organization of the Strategic Air Command. Priorities and emphasis in the Group will be directed toward further developing maximum capabilities to support SAC Emergency War Operations.

- b. Operations Squadron will determine special training requirement, monitor special training and provide facilities and services indicated in Annex A, Ground Training.
- c. All ABG Squadrons during October will:
 - (1) Provide special trained augmentations to activities which are below minimum S&O operating strength (See S&O training and assignments, Annex C).
 - (2) Conduct S&O and other exercises until proficient and/or as directed.
 - (3) Fly 375:00 hours of administrative and training time on Base Flight Aircraft.
 - (4) Complete Associated (Block) Training for 83% of Assigned personnel. (Proportional amount of annual training).
 - (5) Monitor Squadron Standing and progress against requirements of S&O Management Control System and 217th ABG Squadrons Rating System (ASGRO Reg 170-1, 24 June 1957).

(6) Provide routine support and services as required.

(7) Using basic data here-in, establish and publish an October Squadron work-plan. (This October work plan should include CG, routine training, EWP Training, Inspection, Parades, area clean-up, details, etc.)

5. COMMAND: All training and Operations directed here-in will be conducted thru normal command channels.

ANNEX A

GROUND TRAINING

Each Squadron Commander is responsible for scheduling, monitoring, and recording training of assigned personnel.

Squadron Scheduling Agencies should coordinate directly with the Operations Squadron Training Section relative times, attendance rosters, quotas, etc. (EXT 320/2165)

OVERALL PLAN

1. Aircraft returning from a strike mission involving nuclear weapons or those suspected to have flown through a contaminated area will be considered contaminated until monitored and cleared by aircraft monitors.
2. Aircraft commanders, prior to landing, will notify the Wing Control room and the control tower of the above suspected condition.
3. The control tower will direct the aircraft to taxi off the runway onto the warmup pad where he will complete his after landing checklist and shut down engines. The aircraft and crew members will be monitored at this location.
4. After giving these instructions to the aircraft commander, the Tower Officer will immediately notify the Base CBR Section and the Base Operations Officer of the situation including the parking

location.

5. Wing control will notify Job Control on the open line.

In the event of a transit aircraft, the senior Wing Control Room (100th BW) will assign decontamination responsibility to the Periodic Maintenance Squadron most capable at the time.

6. Job Control will call the Periodic Maintenance Squadron for dispatch of the Wing CBR Team. The Wing CBR Team will meet the aircraft along with a Base CBR Team.

7. The Periodic Maintenance Squadron will be responsible for the monitoring and decontamination procedures. The Base CBR Team will back up the operation with protective clothing, radiac instruments, technical advise and emergency manpower if needed. The Base CBR Team will provide the following equipment:

- a. Two PDR-27 Radiac instruments
- b. Ten pair protective clothing for decontamination operation. (rubber suit, rubber gloves, rubber boots, and rubber hood)
- c. Ten gas mask
- d. Six radiation signs
- e. Rope (1,000 ft)
- f. Two PDR-39 radiac instruments
- g. Protective clothing for four monitors (coveralls, boots, and gloves).

h. Personnel equipment and necessary forms.

8. Monitors will inspect the aircraft and crew members using the PDR-27 radac instrument with the Beta shield open. Aircraft found to exceed 10 MR/HR will be considered contaminated and Job Control will be so notified. The aircraft will be towed to the aircraft decon area at the northeast end of ramp 8. Decontamination teams will proceed to this area ahead of the aircraft to set up equipment and prepare to decontaminate the aircraft in accordance with CBR SOP NO. 14. Block 26 Part II 781 form entries will be made.

9. Aircrews will remove any contaminated outer flying cloths and be sent to the personnel decon station at the Base Gym if necessary.

10. After inspection, aircraft not contaminated will be directed to their normal parking area. ABG Form 80 will be completed in duplicate and one copy retained by the Base CBR Officer. (Form 80 - See attachment)

1. GENERAL: Billeting will, because of a lack of additional billeting facilities, be provided by increased use of existing quarters. Organizations will provide on-base sleeping accommodations for their own personnel and designated incoming personnel by increasing the number of beds necessary in each room to a maximum of six per room. Incoming personnel (other than AMC teams) will bring their own blankets, sheets and pillow cases.

2. Billeting Requirements:

a. Tactical units deploying into Pease AFB will require billeting for:

- (1) 200 crew members.
- (2) 102 maintenance/support.

b. Two type B (B-47 maintenance) teams composed of civilian personnel from the Air Materiel Command will need billeting for 102 individuals.

3. Assignment of Billeting Requirements:

a. The 100 AFS will assume responsibility for billeting personnel of one additional tactical unit. Space requirements will be:

- (1) Beds for 51 augmentation (maintenance) airmen.
- (2) Beds for 60 officer crew members.
- (3) Beds for 40 airmen crew members.

e. The Base Housing officer will provide temporary billets for small flights of tactical aircraft which might stage through Pease Air Force Base and have crews requiring "minimum crew rest."

f. The Base Housing Officer will be prepared to provide billets in the Base Gymnasium to accommodate unscheduled diversions to Pease Air Force Base.

g. Assigned personnel "on base" Billets. Because of a lack of VOQ, BOQ and VAQ billets, organizations requiring personnel to remain on base will provide beds for such personnel in their own assigned dormitories. As necessary beds will be double decked to a maximum of six (6) beds per room.

4. Plan for Providing Billets:

a. Organization assigned billeting requirements will meet these requirements by increasing the number of beds per room. Base Supply will maintain a sufficient stock of beds and double-decking equipment to meet above requirements. Personnel deploying into Pease (other than AMC teams) will be bring their blankets, sheets and pillow cases.

The Base Housing Officer will draw beds and bedding as required from the headquarters Squadron Section, 817th Air Base Group Supply for establishment of emergency billeting in the base Gym

PERSONNEL RECEPTION

1. MISSION: To establish procedures and responsibilities for the reception of 106 augmentation maintenance personnel, 102 AMC personnel and approximately 250 crew members, upon implementation of emergency plans.

2. RESPONSIBILITIES:

a. Base Director of Personnel: Is responsible for establishment and training of the 817th Air Division Reception team and for the operation of a Reception Center. He will also establish a personnel status section for the Chief of Administration, 817th Air Division.

(1) The Reception Team is responsible for:

- (a) Meeting and processing all airlifted augmentation personnel and the AMC teams.
- (b) Obtaining 3 copies of Special Orders from arriving Augmentation personnel.
- (c) Notifying appropriate squadron first sergeants of actual arrival of personnel.
- (d) Maintaining flow charts indicating incoming personnel flow.
- (e) Preparing and maintaining a locator file on arriving personnel. (Deliver this file to the Chief of Administration 817th Air Division, upon completion of reception).

(f) Periodically notifying the Chief of Administration (817th Air Division) of the programmed arrival of personnel.

b. The Chief Operations Division, 817th Air Division will assure that incoming crews are met and transported to Briefing/Debriefing Centers.

(1) Debriefing Officers are responsible for processing incoming crew members at the Debriefing Centers.

c. The Base Transportation Officer is responsible for providing necessary transportation to the Reception Center for transport of incoming personnel and baggage. (See Appendix 1).

d. The Base Food Service Officer will be prepared "on-call" to deliver to the Reception Center a maximum of 208 Sack lunches for arriving augmentation personnel.

3. RECEPTION TEAM: The Reception Team will be composed of personnel as indicated in Appendix 2.

4. EQUIPMENT: The supplies listed in Appendix 3 will be prepackaged for use in the Reception Center. Equipment listed in Appendix 3 is in place in the Reception Center.

5. RECEPTION CENTER: A Reception Center will be established in the Base Gymnasium. (See Appendix 10)

a. No physical processing will be accomplished at aircraft. The incoming AMC Teams will be delivered to the Reception Center for processing, then turned over to the proper Wing's Chief of Maintenance representative for delivery to their places of duty. The incoming Leap Frog Teams will be processed by the Reception NCO on board the bus while enroute to duty stations.

6. RECEPTION PROCEDURES:

a. Flow Charts: Flow charts will be maintained to graphically portray the status of incoming augmentation personnel. See Appendix 4 for format of flow charts.

(1) The Base Director of Personnel will establish an SOP containing detailed instruction for use of flow charts.

b. Disposition of incoming aircrews and AMC Teams:

(1) AMC Teams (See Appendix 5).

(2) Air Crews (See Appendix 6).

c. Leap Frog Maintenance Personnel will be delivered to the Maintenance Chiefs of the Squadron they will be performing duty with. (See Appendix 9). The incoming tactical unit with the lowest numerical designation will be delivered to the 100th Bomb Wing Squadrons and the unit with the highest designation to 509th Bomb Wing Squadrons.

(1) The Reception Team will report to the Reception Center immediately upon implementation of the Reception Plan. Twelve hour shifts will be established.

(2) Liaison with the Chief of Administration 817th Air Division, Base Transportation Officer, Food Service Officer and units being augmented will be established.

(3) Each incoming aircraft will be met by a Reception Team NCO who will provide transport to either the Reception Center for AMC Teams or to duty sections for Leap Frog Teams.

(4) The Reception Team NCO will pick up three copies of orders, pay records and DD Forms 93 of each incoming Leap Frog Team member and issue each a sack lunch.

(5) All incoming personnel will retain their weapons, ammunition and tool kits. The Reception Team NCO will deliver baggage of Leap Frog Team Members to appropriate orderly room after delivering personnel to their maintenance supervisors. (6) Crew chiefs of incoming Leap Frog Team aircraft will be given a sack lunch by the Reception Team NCO and instructed to report to the Maintenance Officer or Line Chief of the appropriate Air Refueling Squadron as soon as they are released by their aircraft commander.

(7) After delivery of Leap Frog Team personnel and their baggage the Reception Team NCO will deliver records and orders to the Reception Status Section. The Reception Status Section will prepare locator cards, file DD Forms 93, post flow charts and deliver pay records to the Base Finance Officer.

(8) Upon completion of Reception, a final report will be prepared and delivered to the Chief of Administration, 817th Air Division. (See Appendix 7).

d. Personnel Accounting Procedures: A personnel accounting section will be established in the Administrative Section of the 817th Air Division. Personnel to man this section, and personnel accounting procedures are outlined in Appendix 8.

The closed out register will be delivered to the 817th Air Division Chief of Administration, together with all copies of Flight or Special Orders and locator cards. The Debriefing Officer will advise all aircrew officers that future sign-in/sign-out registers will be located at the Administrative Section of the 817th Air Division Headquarters.

8. The Personnel Administration Clerk assigned to the 817th Air Division Chief of Administration will maintain copies of all sign-in registers, special orders, and flight orders. He will maintain a locator file for all augmentation and crew personnel. He will establish and control an 817th Air Division Sign-in/Sign-out Register. The Personnel Administration Clerk will forward a daily message to the parent units indicating any change in the status of augmentation personnel such as hospitalization, sick in quarters, AWOL, etc., as determined from daily Sign-in/Sign-out Registers received. 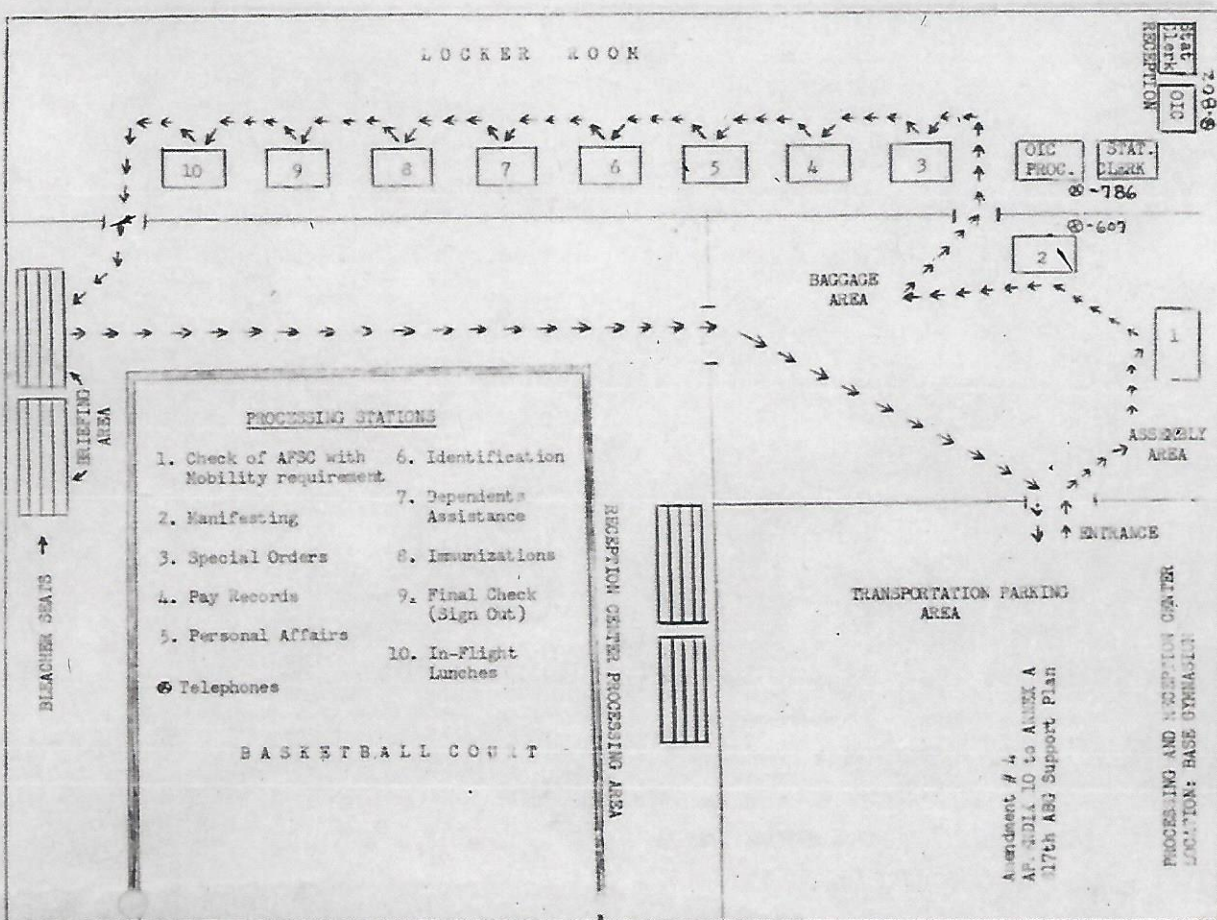

DUTIES OF PERSONNEL STATUS CLERK

1. The Personnel Status Clerk is responsible to the NCOIC of the 817th Air Division Administrative Section. Upon receiving notification of an EWD Alert, he will report immediately to the 817th Air Division Administrative Section located in Base Headquarters.
2. Immediately upon arrival you will establish an 817th Air Division Sign-in/Sign-out Register, (AF Form 1323). All Air Crew Officers are required to use this Register after the registers completed by the Debriefing Officers are closed out.
3. You will be prepared to perform the following duties:
 - a. Establish and maintain a locator file for all augmentation personnel and air crews. The initial locator file will be made by the Reception Center for augmentation personnel and by the Debriefing Officers for Air Crews. The files will be hand-carried to you as soon as all personnel have arrived at Pease Air Force Base. Special Orders and Flight Orders will be attached to the locator cards.
 - b. Maintain a file of Squadron Sign-in/Sign-out Registers. These registers will be delivered to you by Squadron First Sergeants daily at 0830.
 - c. Maintain a record of all pay records received on station for augmentation and air crew personnel. This information will be provided to you in final report submitted by the Reception Center.
 - d. Maintain a record of all DD Forms 93, Record of Emergency Data on hand at the Base Personal Affairs Office for augmentation and air crew personnel. This information will be furnished to you in the final report submitted by the Reception Center.

DUTIES OF THE BASE PERSONAL AFFAIRS OFFICER

1. Upon sounding of an FMO Alert, the Base Personal Affairs Officer will insure that capability is established to support the Chief of Administration 817th Air Division in Casualty Reporting.
2. The Base Personal Affairs Office will be placed on a 24-hour operation.
3. DD Forms 93, Record of Emergency Data will be delivered to the Base Personal Affairs Officer by the Reception Center. These forms will be maintained in an alphabetical file during the period of the alert for immediate reference.
4. A list of missing DD Forms 93 will be furnished by the Reception Center. Immediate action will be taken to contact Squadron First Sergeants to insure that individuals do not have these forms in their possession. When an accurate list of missing forms has been established a priority message will be sent to the parent unit requesting required information be dispatched to you by the most expeditious means.
5. Casualty reporting will be accomplished as outlined in AFM 30-4. All Casualty Reports will be coordinated with the Chief of Administration, 817th Air Division.

ACCOUNTING FOR UMS AND USE EQUIPMENT

1. PURPOSE: This SOP prescribes the procedures for the accounting of UMS and USE equipment when a unit of the 817th Air Division is deployed.
2. SCOPE: This SOP is applicable to all units of the 817th Air Division.
3. GENERAL: At the inception of hostilities, formal property responsibility will be terminated at the Port of Embarkation for all supplies intended for Combat Zones except Atomic Weapons and associated components. Combat Theater Commanders will determine the method of accounting for supplies and equipment, except aircraft, Atomic Weapons, and associated components within each theater, retaining insofar as possible the procedures outlined in Air Force Manual 67-1. Formal property responsibility will be retained for all ZI activities and overseas activities not in Combat Zones.
