It is considered by this department that limited use of Normandy Road as requested would not create any significant security problems. The word, "limited", should, however, be emphasized.

2. The problem involved is the traffic control problem. In the event that the property were sold to a person or organization that would require extensive use of Normandy Road, a safety hazard involving ordnance shipments, etc., would ensue. Furthermore, extensive use would increase the problem of adequately patrolling Normandy Road from a security standpoint.

3. It is recommended that the property be sold with the condition that the Depot continue to control the access portions of Normandy Road. This control should extend to the issuance of passes only to persons and vehicles that would regularly require use of the road.
