1. Reference (a) requested comments and recommendations relative to access to the subject parcel of surplus property. The portion of land lying between the westerly side of East Road and the easterly boundry of Tract A101 at the entrance to the Launcher Area is not in excess to the needs of this Depot and can not be released. Due to operational requirements for the railroad and for Normandy Road an easement could not be approved for a new crossing of Normandy Road to East Road at the entrance of Tract A101.
2. Permission would, however, be granted to local municipal authorities for use of Normandy Road for entry to the subject property if this entry were for Civil Defense or other limited municipal use.
