

MEMO TO THE FILE (Nike Site)

On 21 January 1965 (b)(6) of DPWO Code 61.1 and (b)(6) (b)(6) of U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (SPRING 7-4200, Ext. 125) visited the Depot to talk about the restoration of land at the former Nike Site.

The Navy stated that alterations to the fence and to the road must be accomplished before the land would be re-accepted by the Navy.

(b)(6) requested that the Navy perform the work themselves without reimbursement by the Army since the work merely consists of approximately 130 square yards of paving and relocating approximately 470 feet of fence.

The Navy agreed to perform the work without any cost to the Army. The savings in paper work will more than offset the cost of the alterations.
