Dear Sir:

I have recently acquired the former NINI BATTERY SITE INSTALLATION No. 4461 in the Township of Middletown adjacent to Earl.

At the moment the only road to which this property is accessible is Normandy Road at a point just a few feet from South Gate. This particular road has just been sealed off with a wire fence.

The sealing off of this road is a cause of undue hardship to me. I am for this reason requesting a temporary favor. Namely that the portion of the fence below the South Gate be restored and a gate be installed in place of the fence recently installed across the only road now leading to my property.

I am willing to bear the expense for this and be responsible that the gate in question - the one I propose be installed - be secured at all times. This privilege, if granted, would only be on a temporary basis and I can give every assurance that there will never be any abuse of it.
