The matter of Ceres-vs-Soriano concerning the easement over and upon the property of Ceres to the former Nike Base was decided adversely to (b)(6). The Court held in effect that the easement was a limited one and did not provide egress and ingress. The land presently held by (b)(6) bordering the Earle Naval Ammunition Depot, is therefore effectively landlocked.

May I ask that you request of your superiors the possibility of working out an access route to (b)(6) property property over Earle property. Perhaps a meeting of the attorneys or principals to discuss the matter would be in order.
