SECOND ENDORSEMENT on CO HQNS 52nd AAA BRIGADE ltr NYAA-PD 600
of 27 Oct 1955

To: Commandant TUDR Naval District
Chief, Bureau of Yards and Docks

Subj: Special AAA Facilities - FY 1956 Program - New York Site
No. 53; vicinity of Kearny, N.J.

1. The representative of the Army Board having responsibility for the construction of the special AAA facilities previously served to obtain and submit to the District Public Works Officer a waiver of the safety distance requirement as indicated in paragraph 4 of enclosure (1) of this basic letter.
2. By First Endorsement the Commanding General of the First Army has indicated the opinion that such waiver is not required in the circumstances.
3. The proposed construction will be upon Army property. Final plans for construction have been completed and any change would entail considerable expense to the Government as well as cause delay in this program of the Army. It is, therefore, recommended that the Bureau obtain the concurrence of the Bureau of Ordnance in the opinion of the Commanding General of the First Army that no waiver is required or, if it be considered necessary, that the Bureau of Ordnance issue said waiver as soon as possible in order that the issuance of the permit to the Army for the use of Navy property may be expedited.
