EDITORIAL

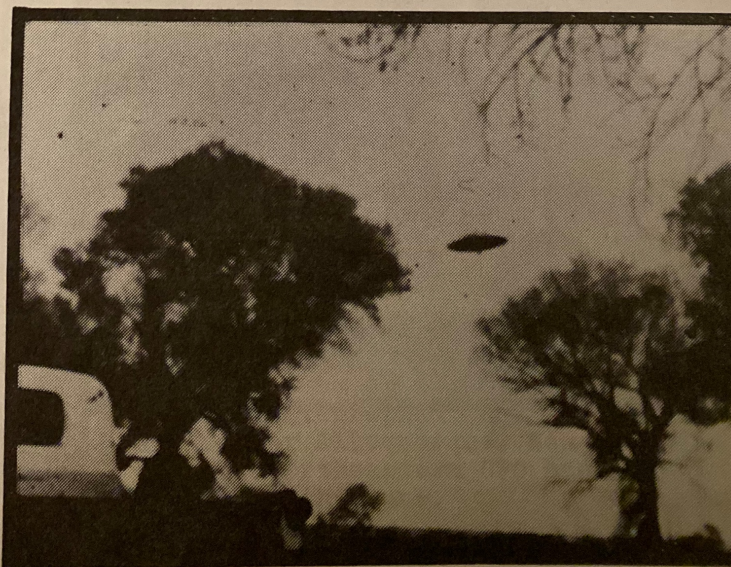

U.F.O. UPDATE **BY THE CAMERA CONTROVERSY IN AMERICA**

On Thursday March 10, 1977, 13 year old Ricky Branenburg was walking home from School, when he sighted a silver disc-shaped object with a clear plastic-like dome circling the neighborhood. This Indianapolis, Indiana sighting took place around 4 PM.. Ricky dashed to his home and grabbed his Instamatic camera, and went to his backyard and began to snap pictures.

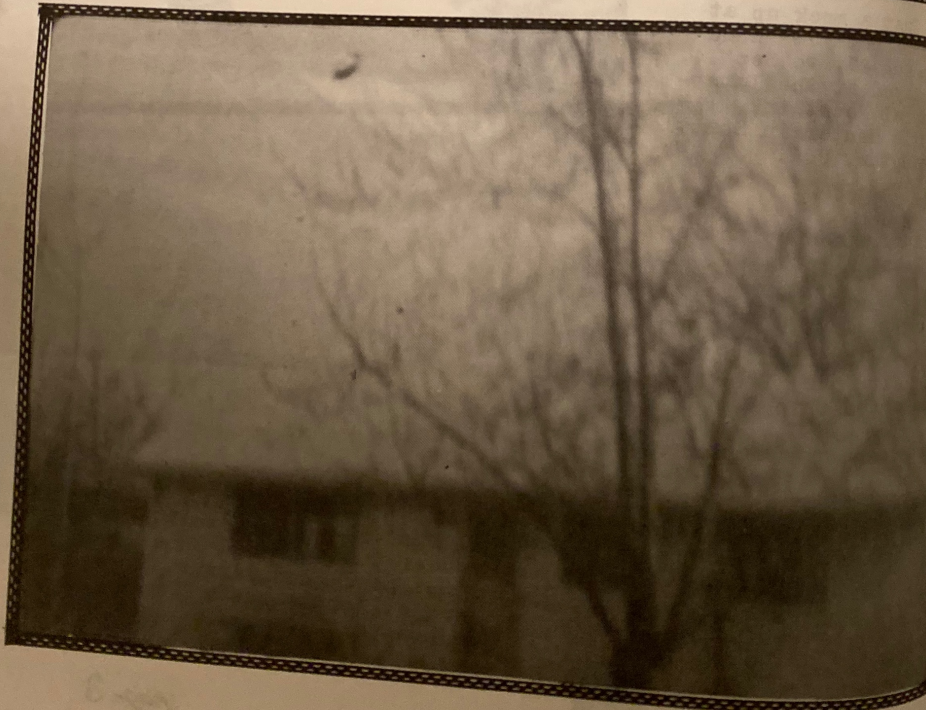
He took a total of six, before the object disappeared into the clouds. Ricky's father admitted that he thought the story was the imagination of a child who dreamed of "Outer Space".

Branenburg, an employee of Trans World Airlines, even laughed a little when Ricky said the object was spinning very fast and no audible sound was heard. After the pictures were developed, Mr. Branenburg isn't laughing anymore.

THE JOE BORDA UFO INCIDENT *by Len Kornacki*

REPORT ON JOE BORDA INVESTIGATION
MOUNT PLEASANT, BRANTFORD, ONTARIO CANADA

On Friday July 11, 1975, Investigators Leonard Kornacki, Malcolm Williams and Brian Berard of Northeastern U.F.O. Organization and Research Studies interviewed Canadian tobacco farmer Joe Borda on his farm. Joe related that on Sunday July 6, 1975, he observed a shiny domed object hovering over his tobacco crops. Joe stated this happened around 5 P.M., however he had mistaken it for a tank truck spraying in the field and didn't think anything of it until Tue. July 8, when he came across the damaged plants while working in his field. Joe also found two (2) greenish-blue oily spots where the plants were damaged.

Joe assumed it was a type of oil, but it couldn't be. He stated I was the only one out there with a machine, and I didn't drive over that area. Joe said that using the cultivator would have turned any spot over.

Joe called the Brantford Detachment of the Ontario Provincial Police when he discovered the unusual damaged area. Sgt. Bud Soroka took two oily samples and sent them to the OPP's Toronto lab for analysing. This is the last time anyone has ever heard of the samples.

On our investigation of Joe's field of tobacco plants we also found a circle which measured twenty (20) feet in diameter, where the tobacco plants were burnt and damaged. Malcolm took photos of the damaged area and it shows a blueish tint glowing effect.

Mal and Len took two tobacco plants as samples. Mal sent his samples to Ted Phillips of the Center for UFO Studies in Evanston, Illinois for analysing. Malcolm has called Mr. Phillips on many occasions, but Ted Phillips will not release the report.

Leonard Kornacki took his plant to have it analysed and found it contained sand, and a oily silicon based substance of an unknown composition.

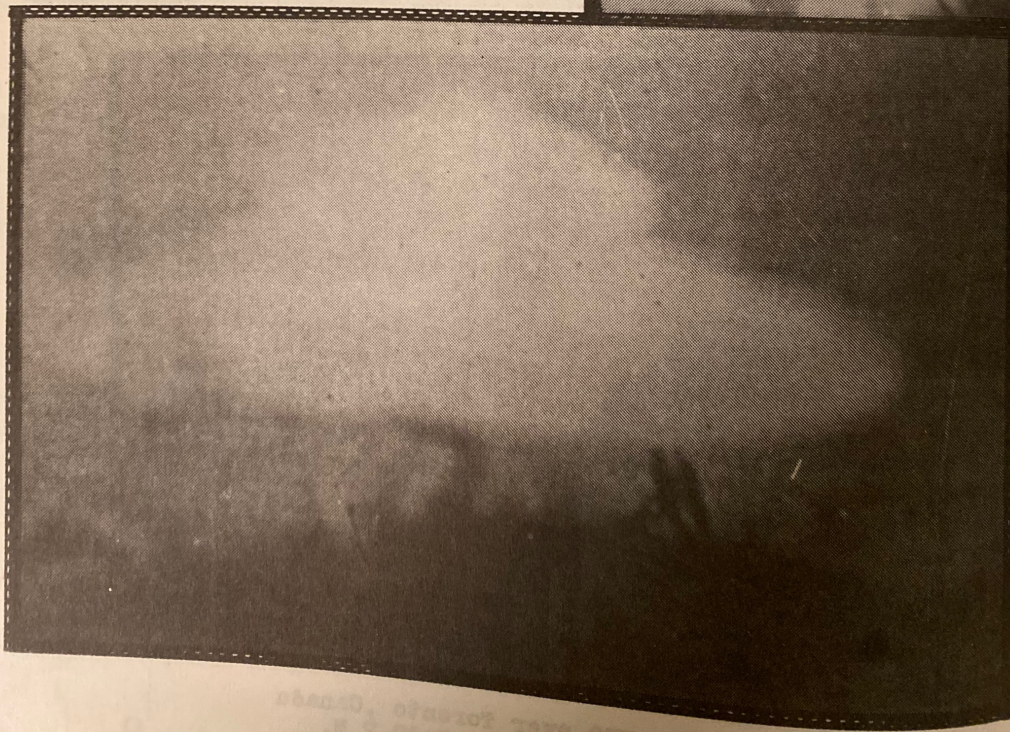
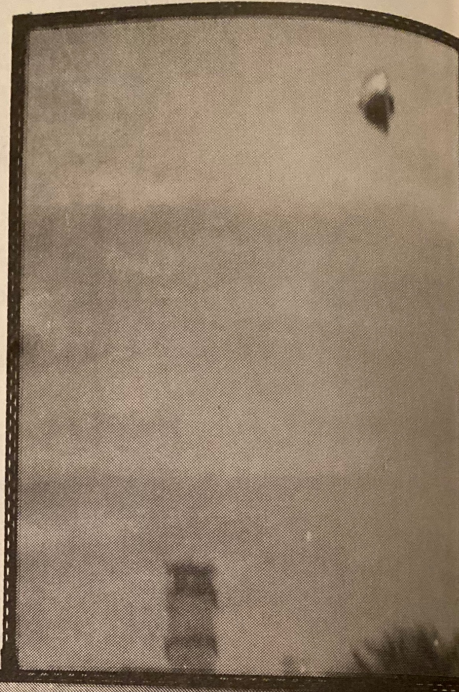

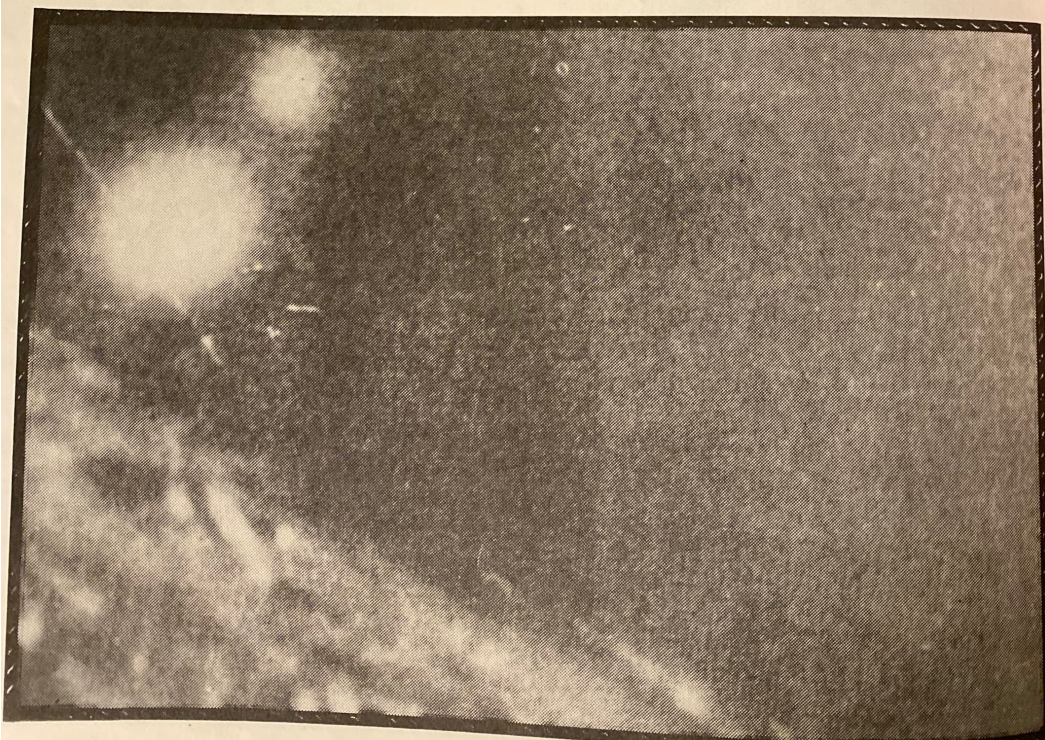

Course Description: This course is a survey of both the current literature and current activities involving the UFO phenomena. It is designed to provide the participant with a broad perspective of the material rather than a narrow coverage of any one particular aspect. It does not try to prove that unidentified phenomena exist, rather it assumes they do. This assumption itself is academic, based both on innumerable reports and on personal experiences of the lecturer and several of his colleagues. Possible theories as to the nature of these phenomena will be discussed. Techniques for carrying out effective field work will also be suggested so that the participant may, if the occasion arises, contribute useful and worthwhile information to the research and investigation of these phenomena.

Topics to be covered will include:

- A general history of UFOs from ancient times to the present.
- "Hard" sightings and their physical effects.
- Underwater sightings.
- Sightings involving apparent alien contact.
- Techniques and psychology of information gathering.
- Biblical and mythological references and their implications.
- Is there a coverup of information?
- "Weird" and psychic phenomena involving UFOs.
- Ufologists today and their problems.

There will also be a guest lecturer who will discuss several personal UFO experiences which have affected his personal life.

On March 24th.1976 at 4:15 P.M. Paul Knight and friend took this photo of a Volkswagen hubcap and tried to hoax UFO investigators into believing his photo was real. Many UFO groups have taken his UFO photo to be authentic. Project S.U.M. in St.Catherines,Ontario was the first UFO organization to be duped by Paul .

Reptune Research in West Hill,Ont. and Northeastern UFO Organization

followed suit giving researchers many months of work on a phoney.

On a recent "Open Line" radio program on station CJRN in Niagara Falls Ontario. Canada, Paul openly admitted he wanted to see how far UFO organizations would go on investigations. Mr. Knight was asked if he had the opportunity to photograph a real UFO what would he do. His answer was "No Way".
