

Branch Plans for time to be spent at NSA during remainder of FY-55.

- 1. In order to place in perspective the assessment which follows, it is believed desirable to set forth the branch's viewpoint on the problem of intelligence research. It is the position of I/TH that:
- The intelligence objective of any research problem should be the factor which determines the method of conducting research.
- The allocation of research time as between various respositories of source information (e.g., Library of Congress, FDD, Industrial Register, Graphics Register, NSA, etc.) must be determined by the individual analyst, in consultation with his Branch Chief and expert staff assistants. The decision on time allocation should be based on expected returns from invested time.
- c. Each repository of information must be viewed as a means to an end.
- d. The research objectives of fiscal year 1955 must not be weighed too heavily in comparison with the research objectives of subsequent years.
- e. The principal requisites to the exploitation of any source are: (1) knowledge of the subject about which the source is communicating and (2) knowledge of the language in which the source is communicating. When the information has been properly translated into the native tongue of the user, knowledge of the source's language recedes in importance.
- f. Although we focus prime attention on the USSR, each analyst is responsible for intelligence on his commodity for the entire Soviet Bloc.



It is proposed that (the only analysts with fluent language ability) spend whatever time is indicated by their research gaps in exploiting this source. It is anticipated that this type of work will require the branch to spend at least three hours per week starting immediately and gradually increase to about six hours per week by March or April. It is further proposed that the remaining members of the branch be placed into additional language training to the fullest extent possible consistent with meeting current research commitments.
