SUBJECT: Contracting Agency for Project TUMS Radiometer

The ██████████ is under contract with the Central Intelligence Agency's ██████████ to develop and produce a highly sensitive radiometer. Said Office feels that this development project is of vital interest to the CIA and wishes to control dissemination of technical data on it. The ██████████

A ██████████ has submitted a proposal to this office, with the consent and knowledge of your ██████████ to produce two of the radiometers for use on project TUMS. The ██████████ proposal number ██████████ proposes in effect to develop two prototype models, Phase I, and then produce twenty production models, Phase II.

The radiometers are urgently needed for use in project TUMS. In order to expedite development of the radiometers and in order to take advantage of the expert knowledge accumulated by your ██████████ project officers in the existing contract relation with the ██████████ we wish to have ██████████ become our contracting agent for the development of the radiometers.

We wish to have Phase I of proposal ██████████ contracted for by ██████████ with the understanding that they will also serve as COTR on the contract and that Messrs. Charles J. Weiss, Theodore H. Vea and Eugene Todd of the Office of Security, Department of State will have access to all data and deliverable items produced under the contract. The Department of State representatives should be permitted access to developments on the project at the contractor's

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plant, but any changes in contract direction or schedule that the Department may wish to effect would only be perpetrated through the contracting agency.

A Phase II effort is not planned for by the Department of State. The Department of State requires that the radiometers be developed as proposed ~~in 1938~~ with the exception that a meter scale be provided for readings of from 100 mw/cm² to 1 w/cm² (uncalibrated but with a rough scale), that the two prototype units be deliverable to the Department of State through the ~~Office of Communications~~ and that four copies of the monthly reports and eight copies of the Preliminary Operation and Maintenance Manual be delivered to the Department of State. The radiometers will be handled as CONFIDENTIAL items by the Department of State.

As the principal CIA representative to the Project ~~and~~ Executive Agent Coordination Group, we wish to utilize your good offices to enable us to acquire the CIA ~~Office of Communications~~ as our contracting agency for the two radiometers. We, therefore, have obligated ~~\$2,400.00~~ for the establishment of the subject contract under Fund 190113, Allotment ~~1938~~, Obligation ~~60100~~. Please have the ~~Office of Communications~~ submit the necessary Standard Form 1080 to this Office for reimbursement should they undertake the contracting agent assignment proposed in this correspondence.
