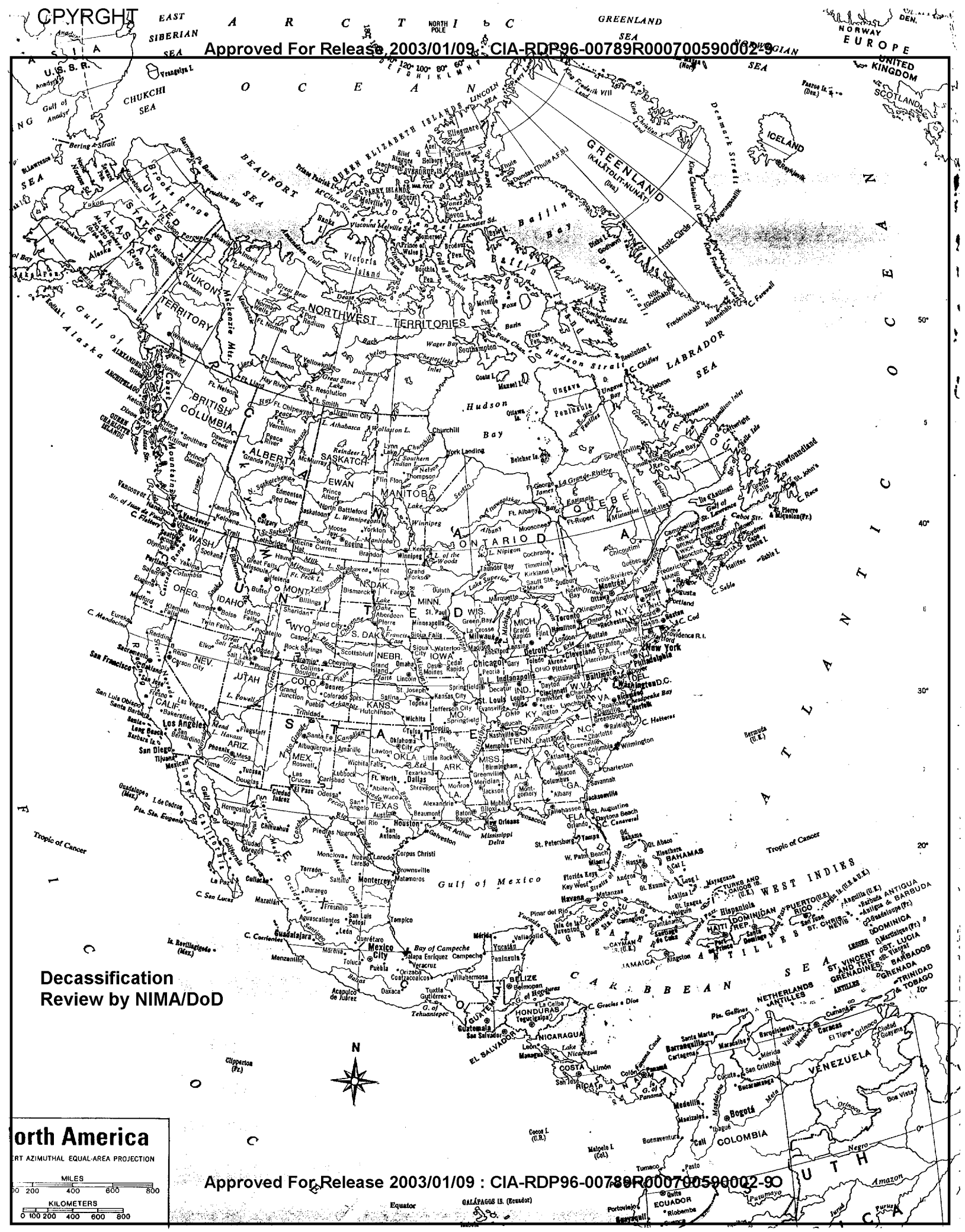

The phonetics associated with the call sign  are Darnel Lumes. The vessel has had a wounded side panel and can cruise with speed. It is long, blue/red and has a little sleeper area which holds people. Cocaine is the form of illegal drug associated with this vessel. The vessel started from the Guatemala area and traveled westward into the Gulf of Mexico to its current location of 20° N - 96° W near Mexico city. This is for the purpose of loading the drugs. The vessel changes its final destination. It is now intended to go through the Straights of Florida and north toward Wilmington, North Carolina 34° N - 78° W.
