(S/NF/SK) To remote viewing sessions were conducted on 24 1. October 1990 to determine the status, location, and Iraqi intentions towards the hostages held in Kuwait and Iraq. (S/NF/SK) Remote Viewer 049 perceived the presence of and 2. undetermined number of US hostages in an area southwest of Hadhar, and west of Wadi Tharthar, Iraq (IZ), at geographical coordinates 35 20 N / 42 00 E. See copy of strip map at TAB A. A second group of hostages, number undetermined, were located west of Qasr Al Khubbaz and east of Wadi Hauran, IZ, at geographical coordinates 33 20 N / 41 40. The "greatest number of hostages" appeared to be detained in the vicinity of Rumaitha/Ramantha located south of Baghdad at geographical coordinates 31 35 N / 45 20 E. The hostages have neither been tortured nor have they been well-treated. Families are often separated; some men have been placed in small, dark, restrictive areas. A building with four large tower-like poles and located near a large archway appears related to the hostage issue. The concept of a "central prison, a fortress," also appears pertinent. Viewer 049 also accessed a place that is predominantly green with a number of narrow hallways and contains

numerous objects which form walls or barriers. This tunnel-like complex appears to be partially underground. Viewer 049's summary is at TAB B.

(OPS COMMENTS: 049 was unable to access the hostage situation in Kuwait.)

3. (S/NF/SK) Iraqi intentions revolve around the release of the hostages through negotiations. A group of hostages was perceived as being kept in a long, narrow, thick building with a long walk-way. The building is reminiscent of a memorial/museum/embassy. The outside walls to the building are made of white brick. A second structure associated with the housing of hostages, appeared to be a tall, yellow, building with a domed roof. The building is a religious building, a mosque or a church; a main road crosses the front of the building. The hostages located in Kuwait, are located in the vicinity of geographical coordinates 29 15 N / 47 25 E; and in the vicinity of geographical coordinates coordinates 28 40 N/ 47 60 E. These locations are reflected in a copy of a strip map along with conceptual sketches and a session summary at TAB C.

(OPS COMMENTS: Information provided by 079 relates to the hostages located in Kuwait. Viewer 079 furnished no information on the hostages located in Iraq.)

Summary of Information

### TARGET GROUP #1:

There is an overall feeling of redundancy associated with the target. Replication and duplication is paramount with this group of individuals. There are stacks and alignments of differently shaped objects. A sickening, sweet smell and a smell of mustiness and dampness is apparent. The group is tightly knit but distrustful of anyone who is not part of the "inner circle". They are a group within a group and are almost independent from their higher ups. A main or primary individual is arrogant, hateful and stoic. He is surrounded by 6 or 7 first level subordinates. There appears to be a number of different "cells" which are separated and widely scattered. The members of these "cells" are distrustful, secretive and appear to be waiting for guidance. Something is peculiar about the first group of individuals in that they really don't belong where they are currently located. There is a sense of absolute control, separation and compartmentness. One member of this group is overly preoccupied with a female member of his family. This group's security and sanctity is based on old equipment and




possibly outdated plans and/or operations. Supplies are becoming harder to get and there is less ease with movement, especially by train. This inner group is highly secretive and impossible o penetrate. There is some sort of major contradiction associated with this group: it is either planning vs. reality or planning vs. operations. These individuals are very paranoid and frightened. They are extremely preoccupied with their own security.

### TARGET GROUP #2:

There is a sense of staging and/or preparation by the second target. It is felt that their movement will be by water. This group will wait to respond to any action. They do not want to be in Kuwait (i.e. mixed-in) with the other line units. They will wait for those units to get wiped out by opposing forces before they make their move. This group will deploy westward from the ocean and move into the central coastal area of Kuwait. This group is now potential the two areas along, and north of, the Kuwaiti-Iragi border.

According to Viewer 049, the (Command and Control) 2. (S/NF/SK) group is a tightly knit unit distrustful of anyone who is not part of "the inner circle." There appears to be a number of different (distinct) cells that are separated and widely scattered. Cell members are distrustful, secretive, and waiting for guidance. Strict replication and duplication appear to be of paramount concern; there is a strong sense of compartmentation. Concerns appear related to outdated plans, scarcity of supplies, and logistical accessibility via rail. Viewer 049 then accessed the Iraqi Republican Guards (IRG's) and indicated this group to be ready to respond to any action; intentions are to wait for

the normal units to get wiped out by opposing forces. The IRG's would then deploy westward from the ocean into the central coastal area of Kuwait. The IRG's are poised in two areas located along, and north of the Kuwaiti-Iraqi border. See the two locations reflected on a strip map at TAB A. Viewer 049's summary and allied results are at TAB B.

3. (S/NF/SK) Remote Viewer 079 perceived the presence of a somewhat sophisticated aircraft possibly coordinating activities with a "gray, square, military barrack," not further described. Viewer 079 determined tht the Iraqi Republican Guards were currently located in Kuwait at geographical coordinates 29 50 N / 48 00 E. The results of 079's session are at TAB C.

4. (S/NF/SK) OPS COMMENTS: Viewer 049 and Viewer 079 provided disparate locations regarding the current stationing of the Iraqi Republican Guards. There was some evident confusion as to whether or not 079 addressed the issue of (Iraqi) Command and Control or the location of the Iraqi Republican Guards.
