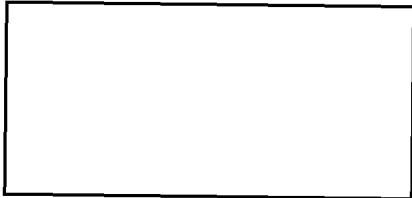

- d. I got the perception of very ~~few~~ guards, except when he was remembering being moved. At that time, he was surrounded by them. As for his present location, I got the perceptions that he was in a ~~solitary room with little more in it than a bed.~~ ~~This room is located in a one-story structure which has a very tall fence (see Fig. 1).~~ The fence is painted in large "blobby" patterns (see Fig. 2) of pastel green and pastel turquoise colors (AOL: like you might see at a day-care center). ~~The place is clean and neat,~~ but has beginning to fall into disrepair (the grass is getting very tall, etc.). The place is otherwise deserted.
- e. ~~According to perceptions gained on a time-line (see Fig. 3), I do not feel that he will be released, but will stand trial, suffer humiliation and disappointment, and be put to death.~~

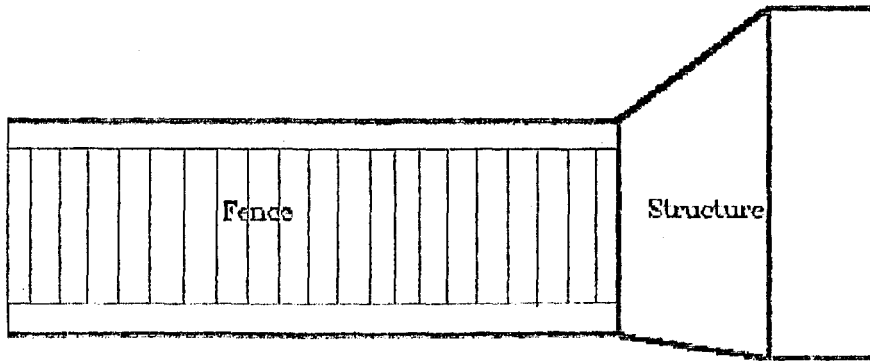

Large fence connected to a structure.

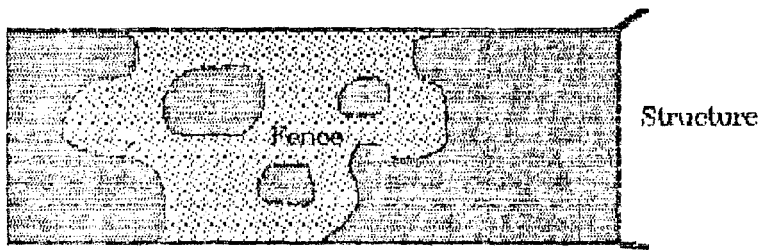

Patterns painted on the fence.

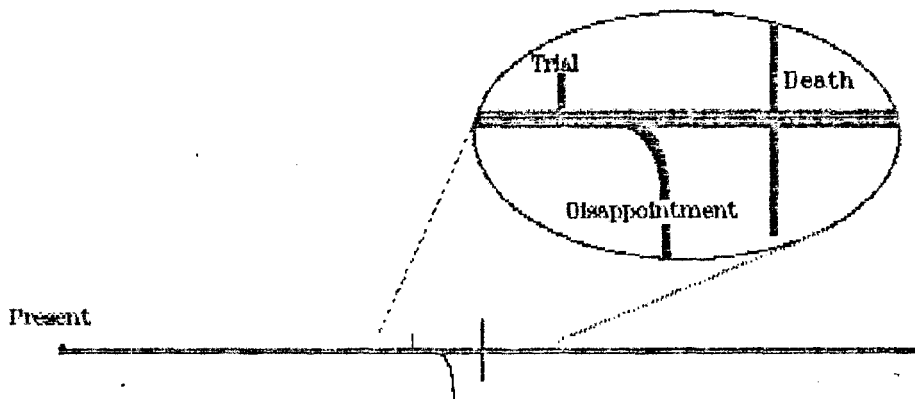
