Vessel A has a tall head with a wheel in front and is cruising westward. Vessel B is long, has a guild, and is crest fallen with rust in poor condition. Women are aboard this vessel. Vessel B will take the cocaine and [REDACTED] to Boat A at the red mark indicated on Map 1 near [REDACTED]. The transfer will occur within fourteen days. Vessel A will off load the narcotics at the red mark indicated on Map 2 near Alaska within a month and a half. The [REDACTED] associated with vessel A include:

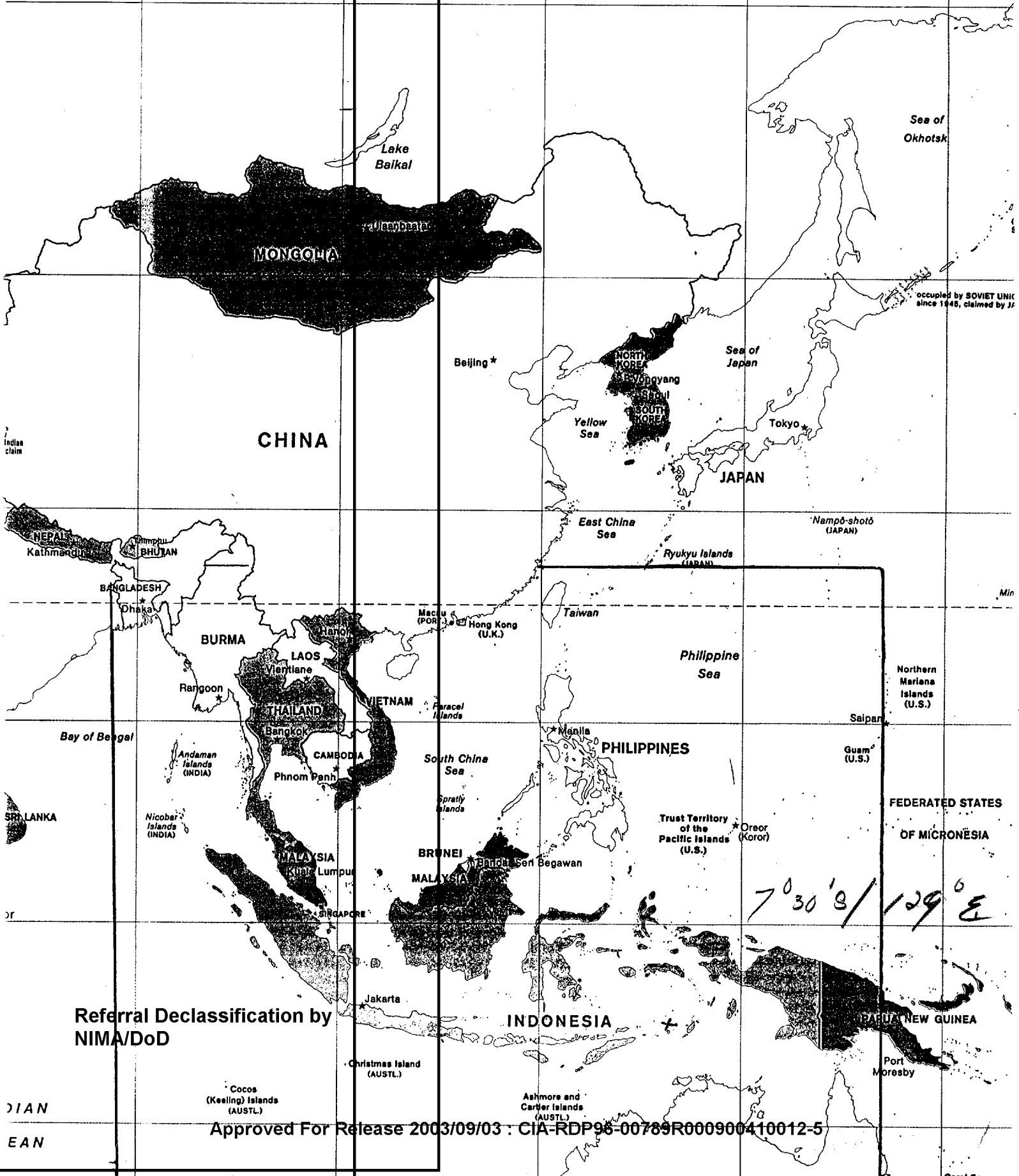
