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1. (S/NOFORN) This report provides documentation of a remote viewing session conducted for training purposes only.
2. (S/NOFORN) The protocol used for this session is detailed in the document GRILL FLAME Protocol, AMSAA Applied Remote Viewing Protocol (S), undated.
3. (S/NOFORN) Post session analysis on target viewing indicates the viever had a considerable amount of correlation. The viewer's attitude was positive.
4. (S/NOFORN) Following is a transcript of the viever's impressions during the remote viewing session. At TAB A are dravings and narrative made by the viewer. At TAB $B$ is target cuing information. Also included is available target data.

Well，sightseeing is what I had．I had a similar，I had imagery of a similar place in Havaii，that I vent to once in my life，where it vas the edge of the mountains，which was a sheer cliff down to，100＇s of feet down，where the low side of the island meets the mounstains and the wind has made it into a sheer cliff．

Okay，if we look at your experience in response to my question，as to what goes here and your experience is， your mental experience is seeing people that go to a high place and look doun into a low place and it＇s overlayed with a memory trace of a similar place that you know of in Hawaii．
