SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

The target is a long, narrow engine-driven vessel. It is smooth, slick, sleek, modern, low, fast with a very unusual shape for an ocean-worthy craft. It is not a commercial vessel. The vessel is carrying a large amount of contraband drugs. The contraband substance is white and pliable. The drugs are concealed in a specially-made compartment in the bow, which is the shape of the bow. It holds a large amount, but the weight of the contraband must be distributed carefully so that the vessel doesn't "sit funny." The inside of the bow looks perfectly normal only it's just a little smaller. The contraband is within something that's within something that's within something. All somethings are air-tight. The drugs are placed within these sequences of holders before being placed on board. The volume of contraband inside is $2" \times 6" \times 18"$. There are 10-13 of these packets. The current location of the vessel is in the vicinity ENCLOSUREL of the Turks and Ciacos Islands (21 deg 30 min N; 72 deg W). The boat is currently in motion. Its destination is the tip of Florida between Biscayne Bay and Islamorada or between Cape Sable and Islamorada (see shaded areas on attached maps). HANDLE VIA SKEET CHANNELS ONLY


