- b. AGC will not accept the DoD ruling, will inform SA of that fact and will advise ACSI to enter into a unilateral contract with SRI ensuring that the human use requirements of Procedure 18 are observed.
- 4. The bottom line is, once again, we can expect at least a one week delay in the lawyers trying to resolve an issue they have been grappling with since Nov 80.
