Task - gave name of suspect, is he doing anything with espionage or in, e.g., criminal activity? Where is he meeting? with who?

No data provided that helped task ^{FBI} people in their surveillance activity.

DB - fund transfers - no data provided. Would have thought this was a predominant issue in mind of suspect - yet never showed up in the reports.

Willing to try anything - difficult problem, need all help can get from any source. Quote successes from police use, albeit this is a different application, e.g., actual visits of para psychologist to crime scene to derive help.

If service is still provided - and file on the case - then required - would task again - probably in cases where participants are unknown.
