 Privacy Act Coordinator concerning request on CIA
 paranormal studies. Response complicated by
 declassification efforts
- Mar-Apr: MOU executed between US Army and CIA, funds officially transferred to Pentagon
- Apr: Evaluation of customer feedback on Star Gate tasking begins at Ft. Meade
- 14 Apr: Official memo to CIA OGC asking them consider declassification issues and other questions concerning how to proceed on Star Gate transfer
- 2 May: Formal meeting with president and representatives of American Institutes of Research (AIR) to consider potential CIA study request
- 5 May: NRC formally rejects CIA study proposal citing prior definitive study. NRC stated unequivocally that "the case for remote viewing...is virtually nonexistent."
