SG1I	Mr. D'Amato believes CIA is making a good faith effort and understands no decisions will be made until the "blue-ribbon" panel reports in late September. Mr. D'Amato is concerned with the reaction of four Senators and the fate of the DIA personnel assigned to the program. He will call CIA D/OCA and CIA EX/DIR to discuss an option, pending the study results, of the DIA "viewers" being offered a rotational assignment to CIA studying foreign remote viewing. He believes the STARGATE staff is being poorly used at DIA. raised, and Mr.D'Amato understands, the problems of "raising false hopes" that might accompany such an assignment.		
	Mr. D'Amato says Sen. Pell is a true believer but is retiring; Sen. Inouye is interested but won't intervene; Sen. Cohen is very interested but not publicly; and Sen. Glenn is interested enough that he might write a letter supporting continued research.
