According to the Beijing ~~Immunity~~ Immunity Research Center, Beijing, the development of Qizong studies from 1979 to 1988 has been unprecedented in Qizong history. The quality and quantity of the research papers were also unprecedented. For example in 1979 only 13 Qizong Science Research Papers were published. By 1988 the number had risen to 831 with 4,591 papers over the 10 year period. In 1979 there were only 6 papers dealing with the theoretical and experimental aspects of Qizong. By 1988 that number had risen to 233.
