


Memo for Record

Subject: Project 8003

17 January 1980

IP Discussion today with CPT Don Wolfolk, SED. Informed him I was having difficulty obtaining adequate ops data from IIPD, ITAC due to priority nature of other work that organization is doing  targeting packages re (project 8003). He told me he would call Mr. Richard, IIPD, and ask him to make one additional copy of all aerial photography being included in the target packages. Cpt Wolfolk subsequently told me he had reached Mr. Richard by phone, and that he would do so.
