

REMOTE VIEWING (RV) SESSION CD-08


- 1. (S) This report documents a remote viewing session conducted in compliance with a request for information on a target of interest.
- 2. (S) The remote viewer appeared to be having a very difficult time concentrating on the target. He stated that ambient room noise was bothering him considerably before, and during this session. The viewer had very little confidence in his impressions.




