

SUBJECT ~~was observed~~ on the morning of 23 July 83 <sup>in a</sup> restaurant. The restaurant was smaller than a normal restaurant (cafe). It contained a counter and six tables.

Subj <sup>was owned. HE</sup> entered the restaurant carrying a briefcase. Subj went to the back of the restaurant and entered a room with four blank walls (cafe). HE picked up a case 1" by 1" by 6". HE left an envelope with seven or 8 important papers <sup>(nfi)</sup> on the counter in this room. Inside the case was a very small circuit board. There was also a small black avian-type thing with an antenna sticking out of it built in the corner of the case (nfi). SUBJECT took something out of this case, perhaps the circuit board, wrapped it in a napkin and threw it in a trash can because he did not want it (nfi).
