1. (S/NOFORN) Train selected personnel in the remote viewing technique.

2. (S/NOFORN) Determine if speech and audio analysis techniques can be used to calibrate (accuracy) descriptions provided during operational remote viewing sessions.

*3. (S/NOFORN) Train selected personnel on tracking techniques.

*4. (S/NOFORN) Determine if physiological monitoring (brainwaves, blood flow, etc.) can be used to calibrate (accuracy) descriptions provided during operational remote viewing sessions.

1. (S/NOFORN) Examine the effect of autogenic training on remote viewer's abilities.
