GRILL FLAME PROGRAM

1. Goals - The objectives of this program are to:

a. Assess the threat to the US posed by foreign work in applying paranormal functions and determine which paranormal functions can be applied to military or intelligence goals.

b. To make recommendation for DoD involvement with psychoenergetics.

c. To accomplish this the following will be done:

1. Explore all variables that affect the functions.

(a) Enhance the signal

(b) Eliminate the noise

(c) Determine effective countermeasures

2. Determine the kinds of targets or intelligence goals that show the most promise for being exploited by the paranormal functions.

3. Develop an applications program for DoD which incorporates paranormal functions with other collection techniques.

4. Conduct applications investigations that will extablish that DoD should:

(1) Abandon the area entirely

(2) Continue to examine the functions

(3) Bring effort in-house

(4) Both (2) and (3).

5. Continue to train and develop abilities of Operational Remote Viewing (ORV) personnel to improve performance.

Milestones

a. Year #1

- Explore the effects of the potential variables on psychoenergetics.

- Develop audio/semantic analysis techniques.

- Determine what is required for target acquistion.

- Initiate work on refining interpretation of data.

- Establish training programs for users of ORV data.

b. Year #2

- Continue to apply psychoenergetic techniques to real targets.

- Closely interpret the results of psychoenergetics to further refine the ORV techniques.

- Complete work on ORV interpretation

- Establish a cadre of ORVs.

c. Year #3

- Apply all ORV personnel to real intelligence programs (both known and unknown).

- Develop statistical base to illustrate the effectiveness of ORV.

- Develop a program that would permit the utilization of ORV by the DoD.

- Develop a program that would result in the continual refining and improvement of the ORV technique.

- Develop selection criterion for acquiring ORV trainees.

3. Experiments (Year #1, 2, and 3)

- All should be relatable to goals of contract and be aimed at achieving the year's milestones.

- Should be established that the experiment will produce the type of data required.

All experimental/testing design, reports of progress and experimental results should be cleared by joint approval of action officers at the Grill Flame Committee level and coordinated through primary contracting officer's technical representative (COTR).
