Source reported information concerning the consulate (Bldg "G"). 3-5 people in the office on the first floor, not hostages. There are people who might be hostages but they <u>are not Americans</u>. This place used for vehicle dispatch purposes as well as serving as an alternate control center.

Definately no American hostages.
