perhaps near water, involving numerous structures, some underground or with underground components. ~~Structure~~ Some structures present are evenly spaced according to a staggered pattern, ~~but~~ reminiscent of grave markers. The structures seem to be ~~concrete~~ rounded, curved over, very solid & substantial, from inside, & housing rows of tapered cylindrical objects. There seems to be 2 types or categories of structures, the rounded one with the objects, & rectangular ones which are more underground and have a different function which is still associated w/ the rounded structures. A sense of seclusion, protection, segregation is associated the site. Few people are present; those that are seem involved primarily w/ routine, & almost a maintenance sort of concern. A sense of "watching ~~over~~" accompanies the site. The rectangular chambers serve a supervisory/ support function, appear to be on 24 hr manning & involve some sort of technical monitoring of the other structures. Various machinery & controls are present, climate control of some sort may be maintained. Chambers are interconnected w/ service/ access tunnels or corridors, perhaps filled w/ cables.
