Site is a large light colored building. Area is warm, not hot, and humid. From the air the air appears similar to Kansas with clearly delineated fields, intermittent trees and some light forestation. There appears to be a large village within 6 miles of site.

Light colored building has a headquarters feel. Mix of military and civilian. There may be an airfield associated with site but more probable is that site was an airfield during WW II.

Inside building to the left of center on first floor there is a main office for one man. Office is large and nicely decorated and has an anteroom with file cabinets/safes a desk for working and what appears to be a brown mahogany wardrobe.

Farther down to the left there is a large room that looks like a Japanese stock market. Activity is frenzied. People jump up and wave paper in their hand in the air. A lot of pressure here. Chaos but organized chaos (NFI).

Going back to the right there is a large room with people sitting in front of consoles wearing earphones (see sketches). Noise in earphones is a rapid fire oriental language. Man in charge

is oriental in lat. 40s named
Woo. Around 5'6" 120 lbs
close cut black hair, short
sleeve white shirt, sweating
and probably has an ulcer. Woo
feels overworked, under-manned and
under a great deal of pressure.
Because of the tremendous amount
of information Woo is afraid that
his people will miss something
important or make a mistake.
Mistake may not be caught by
his superiors but if mistake is
caught, Woo is in trouble. A small
mistake is O.K. But a large
mistake is trouble. When I ask
what would happen if he makes
a large mistake I get a picture
of a brown uniform with an eton-jib
collar with 3 dark silver metallic bars
on each side of the collar. I also
get a picture of an open field with
a few dwarf cherry or bonsai trees.
Lastly I get a picture of a
Tenement building with about 15 people
per room.

I ask Woo what his people
are working on now that is
interesting. He tells me Japan, Malaysia,
ships and boats and airplanes. (Also
maybe submarines but that could be
AOL). I move around the room and
stop behind various consoles. By doing
this I learn that 2 consoles are
dedicated to the Philippines. Also I
believe the console closest to the
door is dedicated to Mongolia, but

that could be ASL.

Moving farther down to the right there is a room with 4 or 6 men in it. These men are sitting at desks and work in quiet. They have a pile of reports. They pick up a report, read it and then put in a separate pile depending on its content. The man repeat this process over and over again. The men are nicely dressed and this job is prestigious. The men are considered executives not clerks.

The second floor consists mainly of a large open area. perhaps a strong pool or perhaps it is being remodelled. There is also an area separated from the open area by a partition. Behind partition are screens and other electronic devices.

All electronic devices in building are large and bulky (tubes instead of transistors?) They look like they came from a 1940's war movie.

The building itself has a new feeling like it was just painted or remodelled. Some of the rooms are pleasant but others are hot, stuffy and humid.

People in building are very professional, male, have a sense of urgency. Moral is very

high even though for some of the people it is like working in a pressure cooker.

Off to one side there are a series of cylinders. Later I think they may be ducts. Raw data is:

metallic
Round
large
in series

At other side of site are two large orange balloons set inside of fence line. They balloons are oval-shaped maybe 20' by 12'. There is also a parking lot and a series of quonset hut like buildings.

Moving around site I noticed a lot more concrete than I first noticed. I also saw some more large buildings that I initially disregarded. This confused me somewhat because I did not see them at first, then when I worked the clock they were there getting in my way. One of these buildings was large with a curved roof and reminded me of a hangar or a warehouse.
