1. (S-SS) Statistics: Viewer: 018  
Session date: 23 OCT 87

2. (S-SS) This session was held in a "free-flight" method on 23 OCT 87. The entire session was conducted as a stage 6 exercise, using the timeline on page 1A. Impressions gained from the targeted site include:

a. 23 OCT 87:

1) (Event #1 on the timeline) There was an impression of a sloping framework, supported by two legs, forming a sort of tripod with one leg extending past the top (see sketch, page 1). This led to an ADL of rocket launcher. Recueing the target produced only visuals of the colors OD and red, which was then ADL'd as a bulky-shaped airplane with a red star on its side, being blown up by a missile. There was, throughout the entire accessing of these impressions, the feeling that the events being viewed had just happened.

2) (Event #2 on the timeline) Later in the day, there was an impression of something being pushed out to the sides. This was accompanied by the strong ADL's of a ship's bow parting the waters. A short break was taken, and there was a sudden and very real feeling of "sudden jarring jolts", which were then ADL'd as cannon fire. There was so much ADL drive on the perceptions of this day that I abandoned the attempt and went back to work on the timeline again.

*Ship firing out!*

b. 24-25 OCT 87: No impressions were noticed.

c. 26 OCT 87: (Event #3 on the timeline) There was the perception of a sudden, downward "catch" (see sketches on page 3). Working through this, I feel that it resolved itself into an allegorical for an event which was "painful, but not serious".

d. 27 OCT 87: (Event #4 on the timeline) There were repeated visual perceptions of a "billowing white" (see sketches, pages 4 and 5). This produced an unusual very quick succession of ADL impressions, listed on the

- e. 28 OCT 87: No impressions were detected.
  - f. 29 OCT 87: (Event #5 on the timeline) This point on the timeline was tried 4 or 5 times, and each attempt to cue it gave a complete package of very vague visuals. The visual package consisted of a man in a black suit being attacked or killed. The entire scene had a strong "European" feeling to it.
  - g. 29-30 OCT 87: (Event #6 on the timeline) There is a wide band of jerky up and down motions on the timeline at this point which consist of the impressions of people yelling, being upset, feeling indignation, outrage, and confusion. There is fist-banging and lots of arguing.
  - b. Activity perceived at the site consists of a group of people sitting around in a circle, seriously engaged in comparing with one another, discussing, and making decisions.

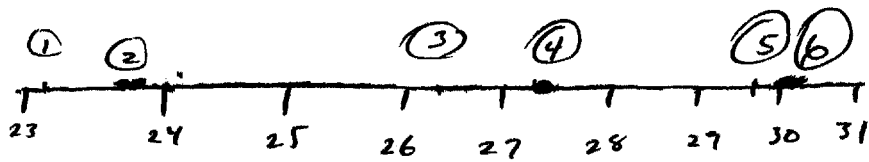

TASKING

1. PROJECT: 8712-B

2. BACKGROUND: Near-time events of significant interest appear to emit a stronger-than-normal signal that lends itself to detection and decoding. As a sequel to Project 8712-A, Project 8712-B also encourages remote viewing in free-flight format, that is, the conduct of a remote viewing session against a specific target without the assistance or guidance of a monitor or interviewer.

3. ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF INFORMATION:

---Access and describe the nature and scope of hostile activities directed against US-flagged vessels in the area of the Persian Gulf for the period of 23 October 1987 to 31 October 1987 inclusively.

---Access and describe the nature and scope of US military activity against the hostile threat (targets) in the area of the Persian Gulf during the period of 23 October 1987 to 31 October 1987 inclusively.
