1. (S/NF/SK) MISSION: Describe the nature of an event of high interest that took place during the Spring of a given year at 9732/1157.

2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: Access the happening established in Session 01 at 9732/1157 and describe the details and significance of the event.

3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: No inclemencies noted. Viewer 018 described a scene of desolation and abandonment as a result of an eruption of a black upward explosion that expanded into a huge crowd. People were observed fleeing and eventually walking to a refugee camp. 018 does not perceive the presence of dead bodies since "they no longer exist." People were merely observed as covered by the cloud and becoming imperceptible. Session started with acquisition of "near-sight" information until 018 appeared to lock on to the essence of the target, ie, the eruption and subsequent cloud formation (of toxic matter).

1. (S-SS) Statistics:

Viewer: 018 Session date: 24 NOV 87 Mode of operation: ERV

2. (S-SS) The impressions of the session were:

a. The session began with impressions of a large place with many people in it. Many of the people were lying on the floor in lines.

b. After this initial impression, there was a lot of "jumping around" to many different places. All of these places seemed to be small homes. There were repeated impressions of breakfast tables with noone at them, and television sets with noone watching them. There was one impression of a baby wrapped up, but with a burn on its face. There was also an impression of a fire extinguisher hanging on the wall, badly charred and burned.

c. There was another impression immediately following that of a ragged edged, large squarish hole in the ceiling (see drawing #3). At the bottom of the hole was a squarish "box" about the size of a suitcase or large briefcase (see drawing #1).

d. Once again back outside, there were more impressions of a housing area with small, inexpensive homes. I then saw a thick, grey cloud high in the air, spreading over one of the homes. Told to enter the cloud and describe my impressions of it, I felt the "stinging" sensation (AOL: like the sand hitting your bare skin in a dust storm). The cloud seemed to have come from the box mentioned in c., above. It had issued out of the box in a vertical black colomn (see drawing #2). The thick grey cloud expanded to approximately 1/2 mile in all directions, falling on people and covering them. Many people were seen running past parked cars. When asked what this grey cloud does to them, it appeared that it:

- 1) resulted in "burned" skin.
- 2) affected joints in such a way that the people seemed to get "old".
- 3) caused pain. The pain which I felt was not a sharp, biting pain, but the kind of dull


pressurized aching pain which results in the head when one has sinus troubles, accompanied by a cold and a headache to boot. It was very debilitating.

e. Tasked with describing the area and the surrounding conditions, the following impressions were perceived (see drawing #4):

- 1) The climate was mild. Skys a little overcast, but not grey and cloudy.
- 2) The area of concern seemed to be on the outskirts of a city (which appeared to be behind me). There was a large structure nearby (slightly behind me, to my left) with plenty of verticals, and "junky" looking buildings (AOL: like a refinery).
- 3) To the right of me, the edge of the city seemed to stretch off into the distance.
- 4) Very far away, to the right front of me, I could see the same curving coastline which I saw much nearer in the previous session.
- 5) The rest of the area was flat, but there was a slight impression that there may have been some low mountains hidden from me by the tall structures.


f. Told to report anything else which might be important, there were two impressions which seemed to deal with the last session's impressions:

- One of the men who had "joined the others in turning blue and wearing the blue hats" (see report, 19 NOV 87) took his blue hat off and laid it quietly to the side, as though to divorce himself from it.
- 2) Another of the "blue" men was perceived, standing with several other caucasian men, in hard hats, looking down into the hole, previously described as a hole in the ceiling. When I was told to ask him what he was doing there, he answered, "I had to see it." When I was told to ask him what he had had to see, he replied, "What I had done."


