- 3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: This is the second time that Viewer 018 failed to provide an overhead view of the target area. Structure previously surfaced and identified as "X-2" may need to be revisited. Otherwise excellent session with a commendable effort to provide sketches in support of the information reported.

- 2. (S-SS) Tasking:
- a. Give as complete a description as possible of the "thing on the roof", including its intended purpose.
- b. Also describe the intended purpose of the building which we have nicknamed "X-1".
- 3. (S-SS) Results: The session was begun in stages 1-3. Once Stage 3 was entered, Viewer was flooded with quick but very detailed visuals. The rest of the session was spent in Stage 4, again flooded by visuals.
- a. The visuals were recorded as accurately as possible (see drawings, pages 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7,and 8).
- b. All perceptions were of equipment which had to do with light-type energy. Specific emphasis seemed to center around a chamber-like area of this equipment where the light-type energy is somehow changed from a perceived white to a perceived lime green color (see sketch, bottom of page 7). This area of the equipment is also associated with a "curtain/blockage" which seems to stop the white light from the chamber and let the green pass (see drawing, page 8).
- c. All perceptions of the target were from a very close distance. I could not seem to back away to get an overall view. For this reason, tasking item b., above, was never addressed.
