3. (S-SS) Tasking: Describe the area and the event.

4. (S-SS) Results:

a. The target area is underwater, on the (AOL: ocean) bottom, near some sort of substructure (see sketch, page 5). Dowsing located several targets, only 1 of which [item 4.a.5), below] was perceived to be the "tasked target", but others of which may be also related in some way. THE DEGREES OF LATITUDE AND LONGITUDE INDICATED BELOW ARE ONLY APPROXIMATE, SINCE THE MAP SCALE USED WAS SUCH THAT APPROXIMATELY 20 DEGREES OF LATITUDE AND LONGITUDE WERE UNDER MY PALM AT ANY ONE TIME. These locations are:

- 1) 60 N/112 E : (+/- North Siberian Lowlands) feeling of intense heat.
- 2) 55 N/10 E : (+/- Copenhagen, Denmark): feeling of very fresh, cold air.
- 3) 42 N/100 W : (+/- Northern Mid USA): mixed and very emotional feelings of disbelief, loss, indignation, hatred, desire to get revenge/to forgive.
- 4) 10 N/45 E : (+/- Persian Gulf): Lots of heat.
- 5) 10 S/130 E : (+/- Phillipines Trench in

Pacific Ocean): Cold, pain, "cracking and breaking up of some physical thing", sadness, lots of pain (perceived to be the tasked target).

- b. Stage 6 (see pages 13 and 14) indicated that the location of the event is in the southern hemisphere, to the left of either the GMT line or the international date line.
- c. The event was perceived as being the sinking of a (AOL: ship) (see sketches, pages 6,7,8) near what appeared to be the substructure of something at sea (see sketch, page 5). Previous to this, there were several repeated "doorknobbed" perceptions of a light green cylindrical apparatus, out of which sticks one or more shiny silver "rods" (see sketches, pages 2 & 3).
- d. A Stage 6 timeline (see page 12) indicated that the time of the event would be approximately 24-26 August, 1988, but also indicated a strange "ghost" or "transparent" possibility of the same event between 26 and 30 August, 1988.

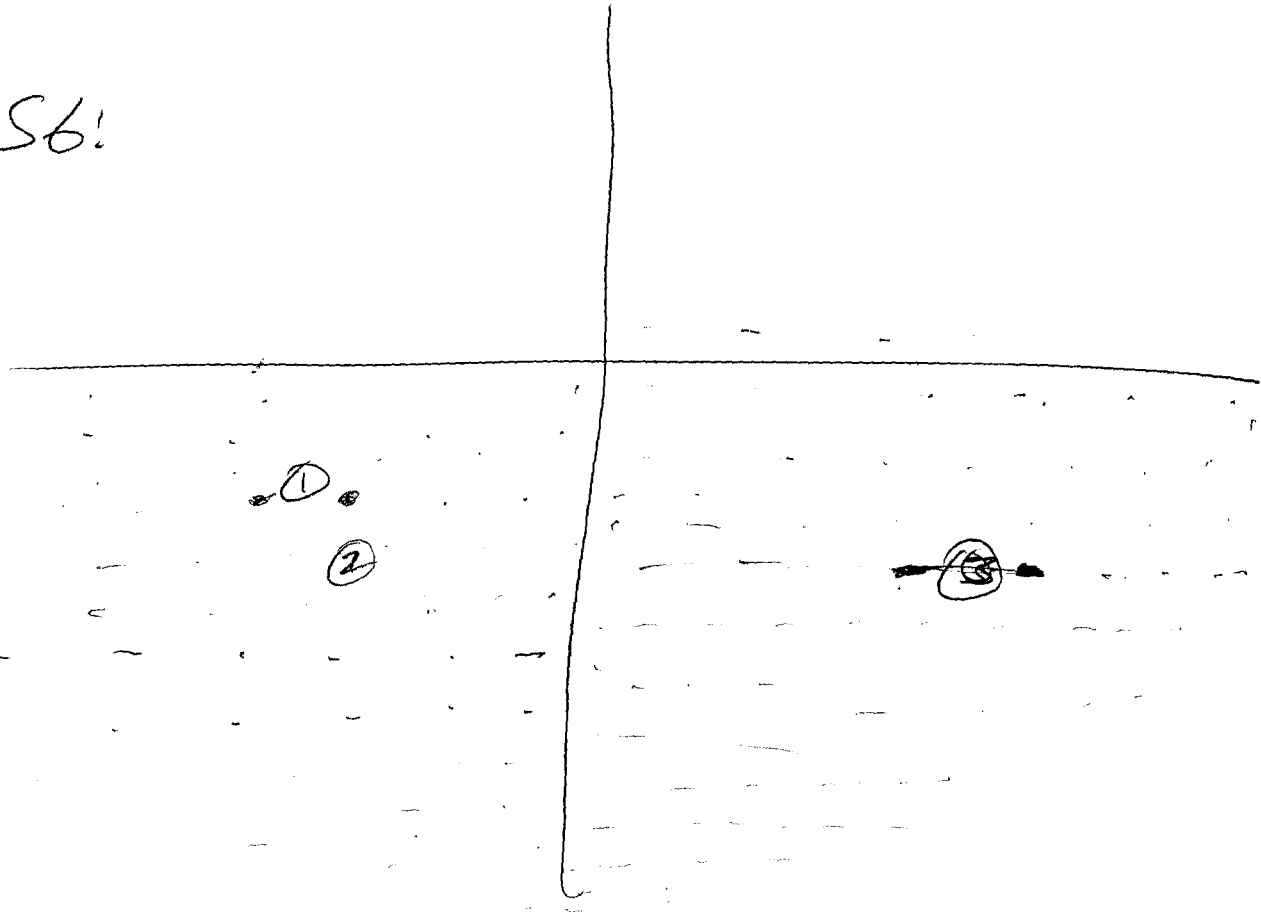
S6 1/2 IMPRESSION OF EVENT ① AS

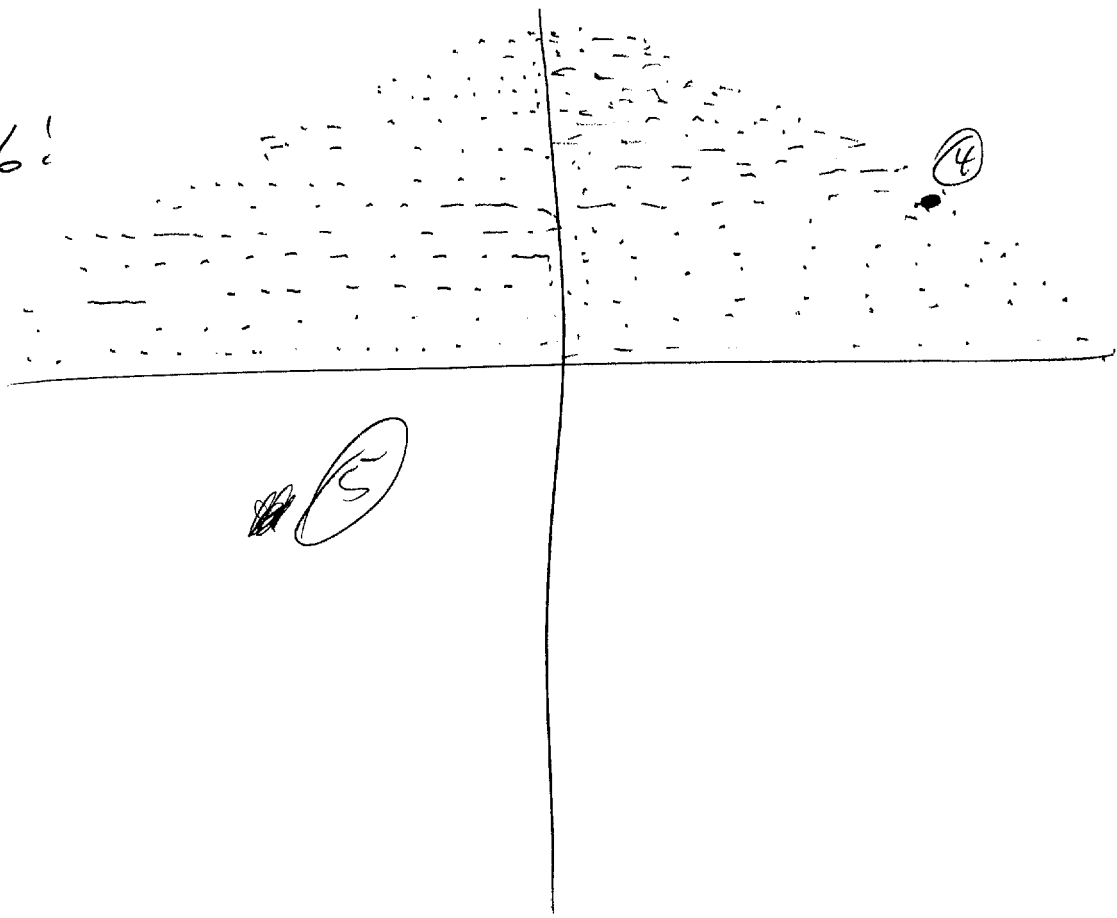

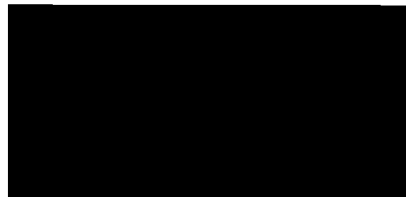

2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: SOLO tasking consisted of the coordinates and instructions to: 1. Describe the area. 2. Describe the event.
3. (S/NF/SK) COMMENTS: During a session break, the viewer reported back to the monitor perceptions of a "moving structure (AOL-flying saucer, submarine) coming to rest underwater." The monitor then provided the viewer with a world map and instructions to attempt to locate the area. The impression on p.12 of the transcript is interesting because of its similarity--especially the use of the word "transparent"--to that of Viewer 011 against the same target.
