The first name of the vessel has phonetically surfaced as "EANLANDER/ENGLEANDER/HIGELANDER/HIGHLANDER/EANHIGLNY/EANHINDER/EANIHENER/EANHIGLW/EANLELANDER. The second name of the vessel phonetically surfaced as "WEYPT/WEYREPT/REWPT."

The vessel is carrying illegal "bullets" (ammo) in silver "holsters" (containers) for papier-mache. The guns are not on board the vessel but already at the destination.

The vessel is currently heading south for a "warm water port" and the name "STUBBLE/STUEBBLE/STUEBBLE/STUEBBLE/STUEBBLEWINE/
STUBBLEVINE" phonetically surfaced as the destination for the "bullets."
