A. THIS IS NOT A CARGO VESSEL. THIS SHIP IS INVOLVED WITH SCIENTIFIC GATHERING OF INFORMATION AND RESEARCH. LAUNCHING AND RECOVERY OF OBJECTS/VEHICLES UNDERWATER IS A PART OF ITS MISSION. ANOTHER PART OF ITS MISSION IS INFORMATION GATHERING AND THE STUDY OF ELECTROMAGNETIC FIELDS/FORCES. THE ITEMS OF INTEREST ARE HIGHLY TECHNICAL SCIENTIFIC PACKAGES TO AID IN GATHERING INFORMATION.
