Defeat by Rightist Arena

Massive Victory Challenges U.S. Policy

SAN SALVADOR, March 20— The Christian Democratic candidate in yesterday's presidential election, Fidel Chavez Mena, conceded defeat today, acknowledging the first-round triumph by Alfredo Cristiani of the Nationalist Republican Alliance.

"Alfredo Cristiani is the winner, and we recognize it," Chavez Mena said. "The Salvadoran people have made their decision and we will respect it." He said Arena appeared to have won with about 52 percent of the vote and his party would work as part of a "constructive opposition."

The election opened a new period of uncertainty for U.S. policy in El Salvador, after eight years in which Christian Democratic President Jose Napoleon Duarte has been the clear interlocutor for a U.S. effort to curb a Marxist-led insurgency. The United States has provided \$3.3 billion in aid.

Although Arena represented a rightist, militarist extreme in Salvadoran politics in past years, Cristiani appears to have swept the vote by projecting a more conciliatory image, promising to revive a drained economy and halt the cor-

ruption that grew rampant under the Christian Democrats.

It remained unclear whether the Arena victory would further polarize the Salvadoran nation, already torn by more than eight years of bloodletting.

After the June 1 inauguration, Arena will control the executive as well as the Legislative Assembly, which is to name a new Supreme Court later this year. Cristiani has argued that his broad mandate will put him in a strong position to invite leftist guerrillas to peace talks.

Cristiani is expected to face an internal struggle between hard-liners who want to step up the war and political repression of the left, and more pragmatic politicians who see a need to attain stability.

The rebels' Farabundo Marti National Liberation Front (FMLN), saying it had proven its military effectiveness in a string of nationwide attacks on voting day, called off a 4-day-old travel ban that had emptied the highways and kept voter turnout at a record low. The left's presidential candidate was running a weak fourth.

While more than 70 percent of the eligible voters in urban centers went to the polls, turnout was very low in rural areas, in part because
