The target vessel [redacted] appears to be enroute for an area located in the vicinity of Fajardo, Puerto Rico, where it will bring aboard contraband in the form cocaine.

The [redacted] will then sail south and then west along the Western Antilles towards Jamaica. It will then sail northeast along the Windward Passage between Haiti and Cuba; and then, northwest between the Bahamas and Cuba while heading for the southeast coast of the US.

As it reaches the east coast of Florida, the target vessel will sail north to ~~an~~ ^{the} area ^{located between} ~~identified as~~ Beaufort, ^{on England} North Carolina, where it is projected to unload the drugs.

The drugs will then be transported on land by vehicle in a southerly direction on Interstate Route I-95.
