SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

SG1A

The [REDACTED] is currently located at about 45N/172W; it will follow a course that will bring it to areas indicated as 41N/171W, 32N/157W, 30N/150W; its final destination is indicated as the "San Francisco Bay area."

The smallest of the vessels identified phonetically as the SG1A [REDACTED] will off-load contraband in the form of drugs from the [REDACTED] SG1A [REDACTED] in the San Francisco Bay area. It will travel south along the Pacific coast line along San Diego, Baja California, and ultimately across the Panama Canal to the Gulf of Mexico. Its ultimate destination will take it into the fresh water ports (along the Mississippi River).

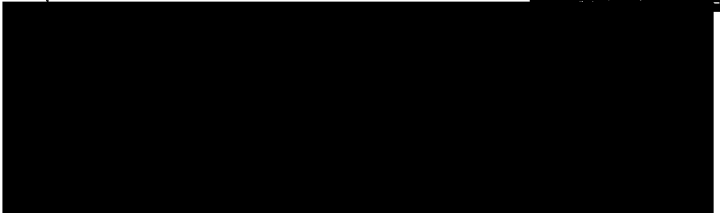
