1. (S/NF/SK) MISSION: Two vessels identified respectively as [redacted] and [redacted] are suspected of having loaded or loading contraband drugs from an unidentified mother vessel in the area of Serrenilla Island (about 150 miles southwest of Jamaica.

2. (S/NF/SK) VIEWER TASKING: Determine where and when the suspect vehicles will unload illegal contraband drugs in the US. As a first action, determine if the suspect vessels will/are indeed carrying contraband drugs. Current location of vessels, packaging and location of the packages aboard ship are of secondary importance. Time permitting, provide phonetic indicators to assist in identifying the so-called mother ship.

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

Both the **SG1A** and **SG1A** vessels are carrying illegal drugs in the form of cocaine. The **SG1A** current location is Savannah, Georgia. The vessel will continue past Charleston, South Carolina and the offloading will occur four days hence the ending of June in the vicinity of Willmington, North Carolina. The **SG1A** is currently in the Cape Hatteras area 36 N. 74 W. and will unload in Bar Harbor, Maine specifically at Milbridge, Maine. Phonetics include: Mr. Purse, Pardon, Pardner *(for the*

*mother ship (also Mr. Henry / Mrs Purse / Pardon / Pardon / Purse)*

*notes indicate the Bahamas to be a factor "offloading" for the **SG1A***

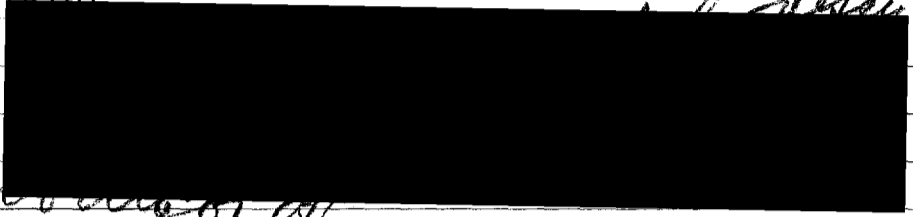
