Summary of Informants

EEI#1: 11° 23' N 81° 34' W

EEI#2: Yes. The contraband is contained within approximately 8" diameter x 12" high tubes. These tubes, in turn, are ^{inserted} within larger metal cans 15" diameter x \approx 20" high.
* (See diagram page 4 of notes).

There are several stacks of metal cans reminiscent of those used to transport chemicals and/or paint. Most of these cans are gray. However, some are black & yellow.

The cans containing the contraband are gray with bluish labeling on the outside. The outside of these cans have several distinctive scratches on them: 3 or 4 parallel scratch marked marks near the top of the cans.

These specific cans/stacks is covered by a heavy ~~canvas~~ canvas or tarp.

There is faded red paint on the wall/hull above the stacks containing the contraband. The paint is faded but differs from the surrounding areas and is visible.

The tubes containing contraband are packed w/i cans filled with an animal product; possibly lard or fat.

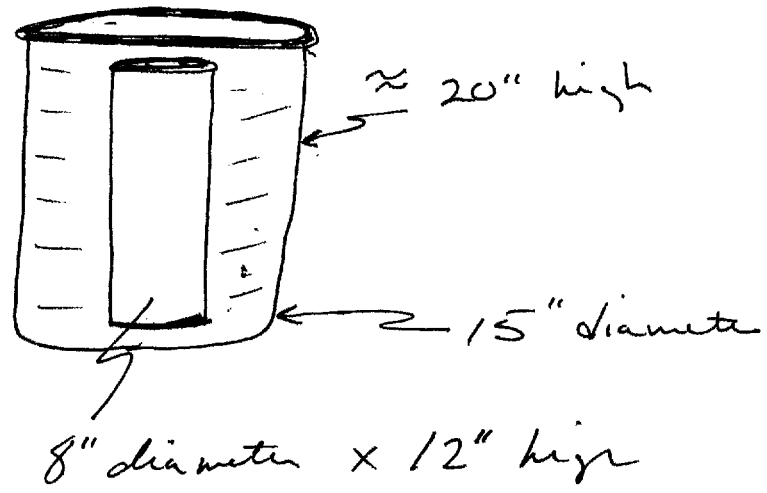
