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SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

SG1B

The target vessel bearing the call sign [REDACTED] is currently located at 10° 20' N / 53° 20' W. Phonetics related to the target vessel surfaced as "Palotriste Olo." The vessel is a reddish brown "fast boat" capable of speeds ranging to about 48 MPH.

SG1B

The rendezvous between the target vessel bearing the call sign [REDACTED] and the vessel inbound from Europe will occur at about 17° 30' N / 41° 50' W.

The inbound vessel from Europe is a rounded, rusting vessel with a dark hull. It has a red superstructure; it is high and sits deep in the water; stripes running vertically are perceptible. It is coming from the southern portion of Spain; it carries a crew of about nine personnel. It has a "latino flavor." Phonetics related to the vessel surfaced as "Robolino" or a variant thereto.

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
