2. (S/STD/NF) 018 reported present location as 2512N 7752W as of 271500L Apr 90. the vessel was not carrying contraband, but was transporting "captive people," which it hoped to trade for narcotics. Prospective transfer was to take place at a tiny island "a few miles due south of Nassau (2457N/7722W), after which the vessel would proceed to Shroud City for a short visit before turning west and heading for the US. Ultimate offload/transfer of narcotics cargo would occur vic Miami area, "possibly Miami Beach." Time of occurrence was not determined but an impression was present "that it will not determined, but an impression was present "that it will not go as planned." the man involved is "extremely wierd and dangerous!"

з. (S/STD/NF) 079 reported that "an offloading of contraband" would occur near 2600N/7800W within 24 hours of 271500L Apr 90. One of the vessels would then sail south and turn east into the Bahamas. 
