REPLY:

By common agreement, a diagrammatic representation of the island was used to submit four locations. The containers were described as smooth, metal containers 3-5 ft long, 2-3 ft wide equipped with a solid protective inner lining.

ACTION:

JTF-4 analysts coordinated with the police who recovered twelve metal boxes bearing an estimated 300 "kilos" of cocaine. The metal containers were found to be water-proofed, branded and marked; cocaine was individually packaged, wrapped, and placed in the metal containers.

EVAL:

Strong correlation to ground truth on the location of the drugs, the metal containers and the island itself.
