3. (S/STD) At 0800 this date, Viewer 025 indicates 19 N / 86 W.
4. (S/STD) At 0930 this date, Viewer 018 indicates 23 N / 84 30 W, at about 50 miles northwest of La Esperanza.
5. (S/STD) At 1100 this date, Viewer 095 indicates 23 N / 89 W, at about 200 miles north of Dzilam, Mexico.
6. (S/STD) At 1000 this date, Viewer 079 indicates 24 N / 83 W, at about 90 miles west southwest of Key West, FLA. Name "Stubble/Stuble phonetically surfaced.
