RESPONSE: Vessel A has a tall head with a wheel in front.  
Vessel B is long, has a quill, and is in poor condition.

2. Date, time, and position of transfer between A & B, and description of any other vessels, with name, they plan to meet.

RESPONSE: Vessel B will transfer the narcotics to Boat A near Indonesia at 7°30'S/129E within 14 days.

3. Which, if either, of the two positions is intended as primary offload for the Vessel A (i.e., 47N/175W or near Kodiak Island)

RESPONSE: Vessel A will offload the narcotics near Alaska at 71°N/167°W within a month and a half.

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

Vessel A has a tall head with a wheel in front and is cruising westward. Vessel B is long, has a guild, and is crest fallen with rust in poor condition. Women are aboard this vessel. Vessel B will take the cocaine and transfer it to Boat A at the red mark indicated on Map 1 near Indonesia. The transfer will occur within fourteen days. Vessel A will off load the narcotics at the red mark indicated on Map 2 near Alaska within a month and a half. The call signs associated with vessel A include: ~~BS-BITS~~, TISTS, STTS, G 3EE, and 2 SFT. There are two sequences of letters and numbers (call signs) with this vessel.
