SUMMARY OF INFORMATION

These vehicles are metallic, create a loud noise, and are longer than they are wide. They are forceful and guided. Some people are at the site. The vehicles have radio communications and light radar dials. They involve some sort of ground control and are military mission related. These vehicles are from the gulf main stream region, possibly originating from Soviet technology. The vehicles contain radio active materials or weapons which travel a short range distance and burst. The objects inside are engaged / set off by the vehicles and move with great speed. They are direct and can go over water. Ship to shore communications are active when the vehicles are in combat.
