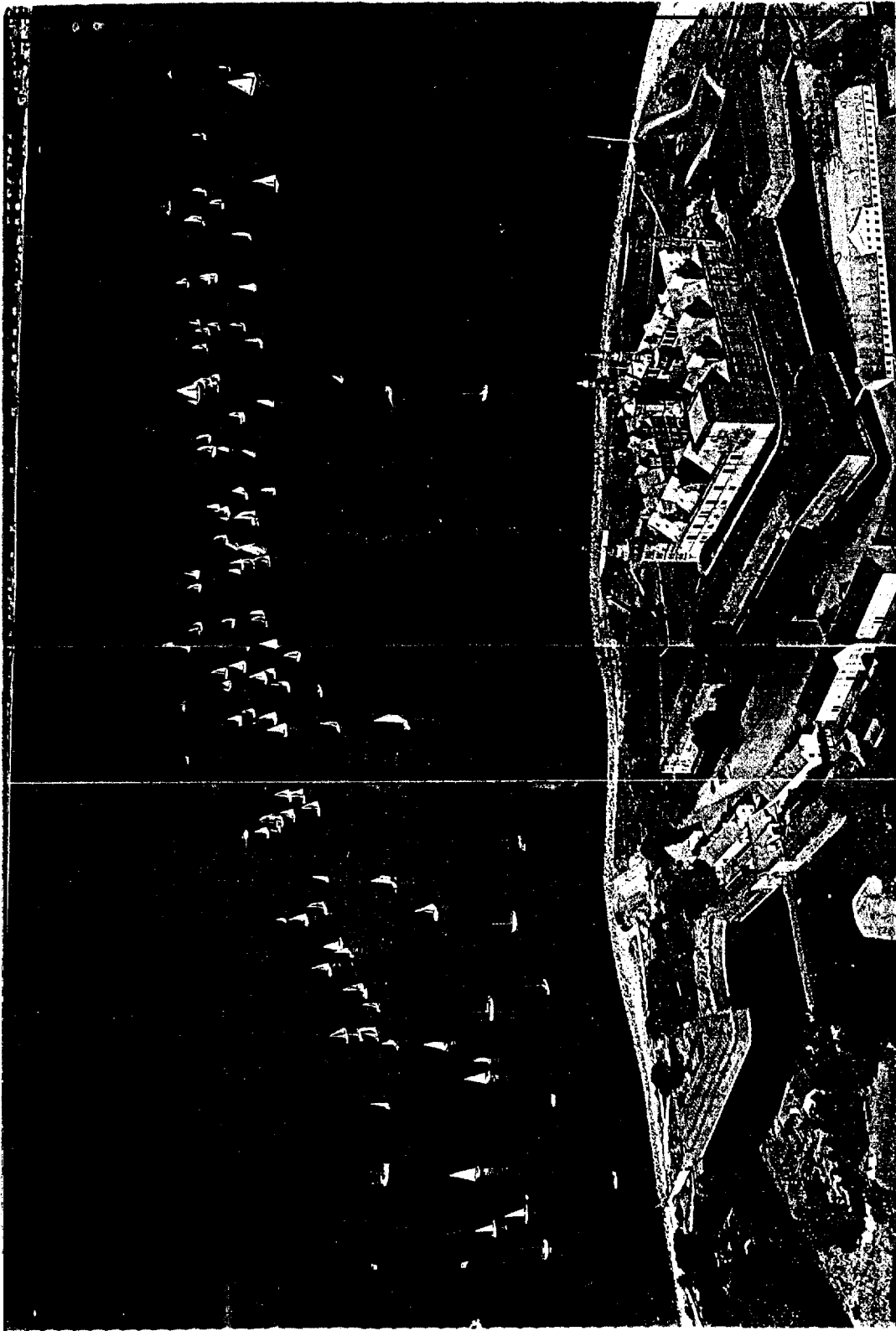


TRACKER of actual view of target *Page 8*
