## SESSION SUMMARY

### MORNING SESSION

#### SITE I (Baltic Sea)

..... still having problems with the feeling of the site. the motion of this site was similar to most other large bodies of water.... however, the feeling came through as warm and grainy.

#### SITE II (Turkish Caves)

..... first impression were of steep inclines, peaks, inclines up and down.... a feeling of hard surface. later on in the session another ideogram developed which was circular. Probing this ideogram within the circle did not produce any kind of a feeling at all.

### AFTERNOON SESSION

#### SITE I (MT. HOOD)

..... site felt hard... many curves and angles.... this site also contained a bowl shaped feeling... misinterpreted as being a man-made structure

#### SITE II (Everglades Swamp)

..... curve up, peak, incline down, curve up, incline down. .... feeling of being hard.....

### OVERALL

Still having difficulty with "feeling" the site. Seem to be getting into a rut with the ideograms. They are all similar, even though they represent a totally different gestalt. Perhaps some doodling might help loosen things up a bit.
