SESSION SUMMARY

MORNING / SITE I (Mountain in Aleutian chain)

....feeling was more definite on this site.... ideogram and motion were very similar to previous mountain sites. However, on the third cue there was an overpowering vertical motion and feeling of hardness.... still had difficulty determining whether site was natural or man-made. When probing the ideogram the site felt uneven and rugged, indicating that it was not man-made.


AFTERNOON / SITE I (Crater Lake)

.....very difficult time with the feeling of this site.... the feeling was just not coming through. There seemed to be a lot of "noise" this afternoon. Of interest was the final ideogram which represented two separate gestalts. The first part of the ideogram appeared to be a horizontal representation of one major gestalt and the second part of the ideogram felt more like a vertical or oblique view of the combined gestalts.

COMMENT: some ideograms may tend to be upside-down or mirror image of site gestalt.
