SITE IL (LAKE GEORGE) ..... land, water, mountain interface ..... this interpretation is accurate, however the body of water is misinterpreted as open and salty... ocean. ..... definitely perceived water, shorelin and mountains in background

AFTERNOON

SITE I ( MOUNTAINS) .... smooth , vertical feeling .... felt more natural though .....

SITE II ( RUINS IN PERU) ..... vertical up feeling .... definitely hard throughout session ..... eventually decoded signal as vertical up, across, verticalup, across, vetical up across, etc. .... there was some confusion in the begining as to whether this was a mountain or a structure .... there seems to be a very subtle difference between a peak and a right angle at this stage .....
